1. TWV (Total Words Written): count up total of group of letters (can be nonsense, not actually needing to be word to count)
2. WSC (words spelled correctly): count the total words that are spelled correctly, do not count off for capitalization/punctuation/dyslexia errors)
 - a. EXAMPLES:
 - b. dog/bog
 - c. Bob/bob
 - d. Mary's cat/marys cat
 - e. All above are still spelled correctly and counted
3. CWS (Correct Writing Sequence): Count the total of "carrots" in between the words that are spelled correctly.
 - a. EXAMPLES:
 - b. ^It was^dark^.^Nobody^could ~~seen~~ the ^trees^of^the ~~forrest~~
 - c. Total of "carrots"=CWS
 - d. Only add carrots where both words in front and behind are spelled correctly or used correctly
