A rider is	Something dealing with an unrelated subject that is added to a bill.
The Committee of the Whole	Is a different form of the house and speeds up the deciding process of a bill.
A discharge position	Enables members to force a bill that has remained in committee 30 days onto the floor for consideration.
A filibuster	Is an attempt to "talk a bill to death"
A Cloture	Limits debate, to speed up the process of debate on a bill.
If a President vetos a bill, Congress	May pass the bill on the two-thirds vote or amend the bill and resend it to the President.
A pocket veto	Happens when Congress adjourns its session within ten days of submitting the bill to the President and the President does not act, the measure dies.
