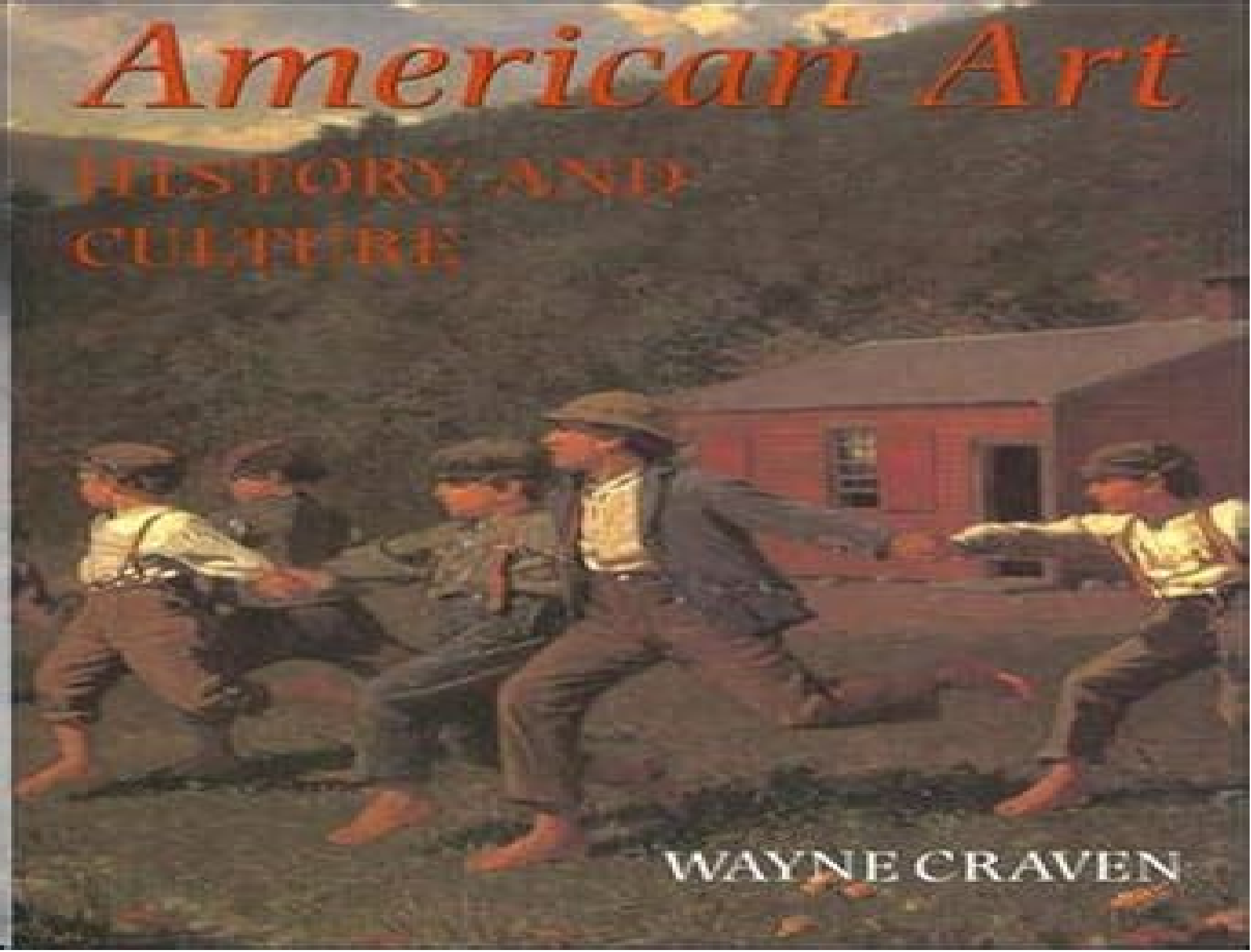

Trouble in Paradise Alan Wallach, 2024-11-04 A collection of highly readable critical essays 1977-2023 by a leader in the field of American social art history Among the subjects Alan Wallach explores are the art of Thomas Cole patronage of the Hudson River School so called Luminism the rise of the American art museum the historiography of American art scholarship and the art market as well as the work of Augustus Saint Gaudens Rockwell Kent Grant Wood Philip Evergood and Norman Rockwell Throughout Wallach employs a materialist approach to argue against traditional scholarship that considered American art and art institutions in isolation from their social historical and ideological contexts

The Apotheosis of Democracy, 1908-1916 Thomas P. Somma, 1995 The art of Paul Wayland Bartlett 1865-1925 and turn of the century sculpture in general have been attracting increasing attention A leading American sculptor of international reputation Bartlett was one of the best known artists in the United States Bartlett's sculptural decoration for the House pediment at the U S Capitol Building was his most prestigious public monument and one of the most historically important federal commissions to be awarded in the United States during the early twentieth century Its installation in the long vacant House pediment finally brought to completion a project of Capitol expansion that had begun more than a half century earlier As such it provides a valuable opportunity for exploring the early development of government sponsored public sculpture in the United States Unveiled just eight months prior to U S entry into World War I the pediment also represents one of the most visible public expressions of the ideals of the late American Renaissance 1876-1917

Johnson, 1994-03-01 **American Paradise** Metropolitan Museum of Art (New York, N.Y.), 1987 Traces the history of the Hudson River School of American painters shows works by Church Cole and Inness and describes the background of each painting **Arcadian Waters and Wanton Seas** Arne Neset, 2009 The nineteenth century was the great age of landscape painting in Europe and America In an era of rapid industrialization and transformation of landscape pictures of natural scenes were what people wanted most to display in their homes The most popular and marketable pictures often degenerating into kitsch showed a wilderness with a pond or a lake in which obtrusive signs of industry and civilization had been edited out Inspired by Romantic ideas of the uniqueness of the nation pictorial and literary art was supposed to portray the soul of the nation and the spirit of place a view commonly adopted by cultural and art historians on both sides of the Atlantic Arcadian Waters and Wanton Seas argues that nationalistic or exceptionalist interpretations disregard deep rooted iconological traditions in transatlantic culture Depictions and ideas of nature go back to the classical ideas of Arcadia and Eden in which fountains ponds lakes rivers and finally the sea itself are central elements Following their European colleagues American artists typically portrayed the American Arcadia through the classical conventions Arcadian Waters and Wanton Seas adopts the interdisciplinary and comparative methodological perspectives that characterize American studies The book draws on art history cultural history literature and the study of the production and use of visual images and will serve well as a textbook for courses on American studies or cultural history of the Western world **The American West in Bronze, 1850-1925** Thayer Tolles, Thomas Brent Smith, 2013 Themes of the American West have been enduringly popular and The American West in Bronze features sixty five iconic bronzes that display a range of subjects from portrayals of the noble Indian to rough and tumble scenes of rowdy cowboys to tributes to the pioneers who settled the lands west of the Mississippi Fascinating texts offer a fresh look at the roles that artists played in creating interpretations of the vanishing West Whether
