The description of ideal forms of Louise brought her sufferings and inner instability. The author used a number of associated epithets to provide the reader with a detailed characterization of the society by which Louise was surrounded, "thin, flat-chested, gangling... Joan". (126) The author stresses how generally accepted norms influenced her inner world and changed her perception of the environment.

Andre Dubus wanted to show that those who are treated differently in our society are always afraid to open their mind to close friends; they are constantly living in their own world. "Louise lived in a small city Louisiana" (129) The same is illustrated in the example of Louise whose friends though being very close never knew her. "She never
