Cell Structure

Cell: The basic unit of life.

Prokaryotic Cell: A cell without a nucleus.

Eukaryotic Cell: A cell with a nucleus.

Organelles: Structures within a cell that perform specific functions.

- Nucleus:** Contains genetic material (DNA).
- Mitochondria:** Site of cellular respiration.
- Rough Endoplasmic Reticulum:** Site of protein synthesis.
- Smooth Endoplasmic Reticulum:** Site of lipid synthesis.
- Golgi Apparatus:** Site of protein modification and transport.
- Lysosomes:** Site of cellular waste disposal.

Connective Tissues

Definition: Tissues that support and connect other tissues.

Types:

- Epithelial Tissue:** Covers the body and organs.
- Muscle Tissue:** Contracts to produce movement.
- Nervous Tissue:** Transmits electrical signals.
- Connective Tissue:** Supports and connects other tissues.

Muscle Tissue

Definition: Tissue that contracts to produce movement.

Types:

- Skeletal Muscle:** Voluntary muscle.
- Cardiac Muscle:** Involuntary muscle.
- Smooth Muscle:** Involuntary muscle.

Nervous Tissue

Definition: Tissue that transmits electrical signals.

Types:

- Neuron:** The basic unit of the nervous system.
- Glia:** Support cells for neurons.

Integumentary System

Definition: The system that covers the body.

Components:

- Skin:** The outer layer of the body.
- Hair:** Projections from the skin.
- Nails:** Hard structures at the end of fingers and toes.

Endocrine System

Definition: The system that regulates the body's functions.

Components:

- Hypothalamus:** The brain's control center.
- Pituitary Gland:** The master gland.
- Thyroid Gland:** Regulates metabolism.
- Adrenal Gland:** Regulates stress response.
- Pancreas:** Regulates blood sugar.
- Gonads:** Reproductive glands.

Immune System

Definition: The system that defends the body against disease.

Components:

- White Blood Cells:** Fight infection.
- Antibodies:** Proteins that neutralize pathogens.
- Macrophages:** Eat and destroy pathogens.
- Lymph Nodes:** Filter out pathogens.

Respiratory System

Definition: The system that takes in oxygen and removes carbon dioxide.

Components:

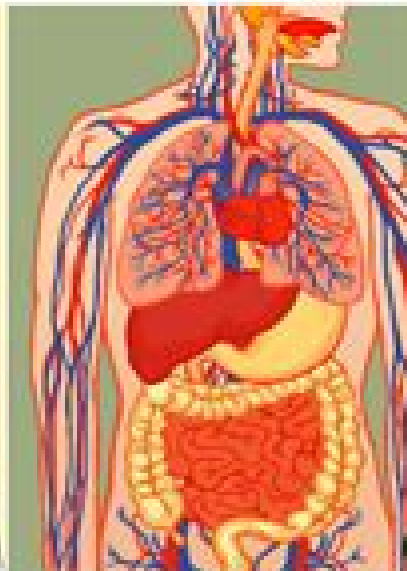
- Nose:** Entry point for air.
- Trachea:** Windpipe.
- Lungs:** Organs where gas exchange occurs.

Circulatory System

Definition: The system that transports blood throughout the body.

Components:

- Heart:** Pumps blood.

- Venae Cavae:** Carry deoxygenated blood.
