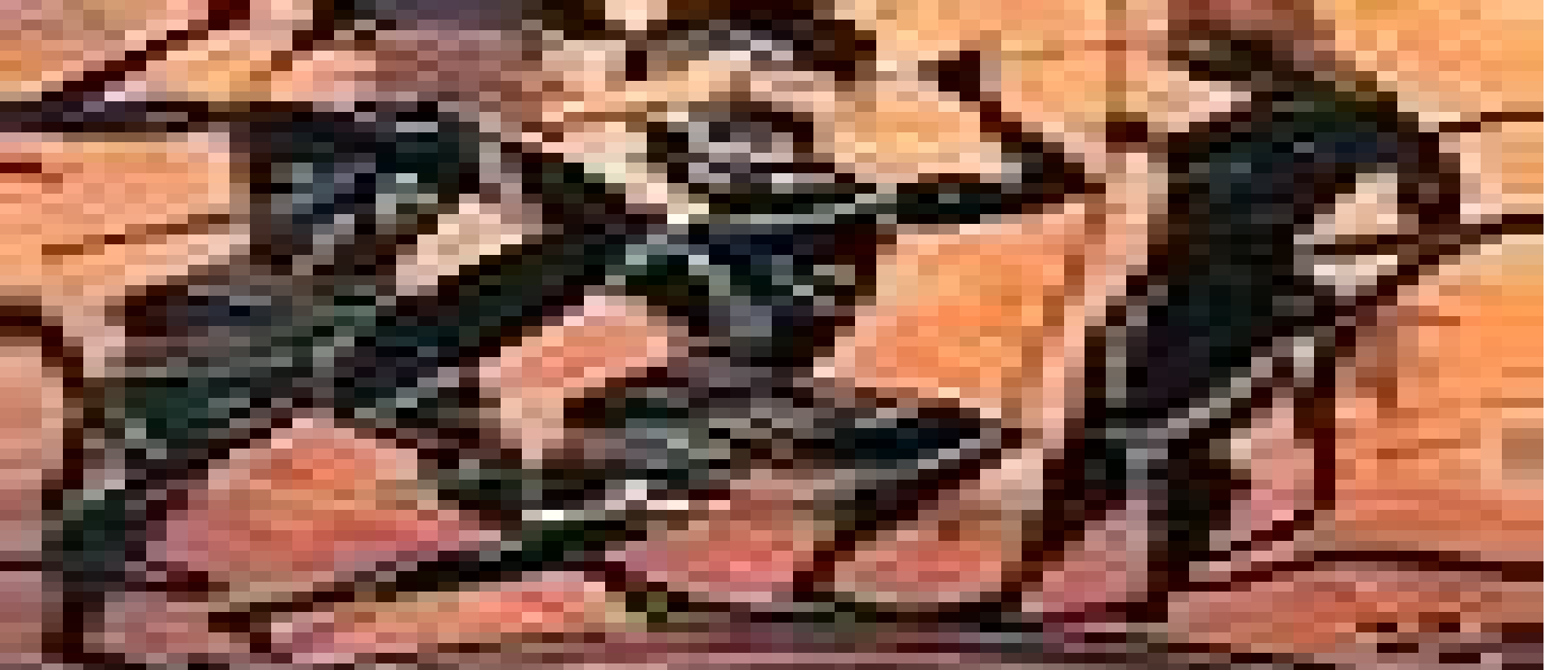

emerged those of ancient Greece and ancient India This is the second book in a new series which presents the emergence of Western psychology in a global context The author begins by building a bridge between evolutionary psychology and the history of psychology From one side this bridge is an evolutionary account of human culture From the other it is a narrative of human evolution using the latest fossil and genetic evidence Finally linguistics and anthropology link the appearance of our species with the emergence of ancient psychologies Central to this is the role of the shaman figure in all ancient cultures which is connected to the origins of psychological language The key words psyche mind conscious and unconscious and logos talk discourse reason will find their permanent meanings in Greece before they are combined to form psychology in Plato Parallel terms in India such as atman the universal self and manas mind also find their range of meanings Ancient Europe and ancient India two wings of the Indo European world are introduced as distinct cultures related by language each developing distinct psychological traditions Descriptions and explanations of mental phenomena are traced from Homer to Plato and in India from the Vedas to the Upanishads In each case these are related to the competing psychologies of religious cults as manifestations of shamanism leading to the birth of world psychologies Presented in an accessible manner this is an excellent resource for students and teachers of psychology philosophy history linguistics archaeology and anthropology as well as general readers who want to learn more about the origins of psychology on a global stage This title follows on from *The Global Origins of Psychology Neurology Language and Culture in the Ancient World* It applies the same framework to the Indo European world

any historical reality The final four chapters provide a wider context for the Aegean story surveying the eastern Mediterranean including Cyprus and the Levant and the themes of subsistence and warfare

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
