New York State Requirements for Arts Education

At the elementary level, in grades 1-6, the New York State Education Department (NYSED) requires that students receive instruction in dance, music, theater and visual arts in every grade. In addition, NYSED recommends that students spend a specific allocation of lesson learning in the arts.¹

At the middle school level, in grades 7 and 8, the NYSED expects that students achieve, by the end of grade 8, one half-unit of study in visual arts and one half-unit of study in music. NYSED has allowed New York City schools to offer any one of the art forms to meet the requirements.

At the high school level, the New York State Education Department requires that all students graduate having earned one unit or two credits in the arts (dance, music, theater and/or visual arts). Eligible schools have the option of offering at three or five year sequence in any one of the four art forms. Students who complete three units in a single art form and successfully complete the exit exam in that art form are eligible to receive a Regents Standard Diploma with advanced designation in the arts.

Description of School's Arts Programs

This school has submitted the following description of its arts program:

Within the context of New York State Standards, the goal of the Arts Program of Midway Green College Preparatory School is to provide a learning environment where students can nurture their innate creative abilities while simultaneously learning fundamental aspects of the underlying principles of the art forms, along with its specific history and culture. The Arts Program offers classes designed to help students to develop information-specific and performance-specific skills in dance, music and the visual arts. Creative impulses are nurtured and refined in an artistic environment by teachers, who are themselves practicing artists, as well as state-certified pedagogues. State-of-the-art facilities, i.e., a professional dance studio, an art studio equipped with tools, photography laboratory and pottery wheels, and a music studio provide the environment needed for a wide array of courses. Exhibits of creative art work and performances are the cumulative, intentional project to student undertakes to showcase skills development.
