Many diverse natural substances and chemical derivatives of natural or synthetic compounds as well as beneficial microorganisms are cataloged as plant biostimulants including: i humic substances ii plant or animal based protein hydrolysates iii macro and micro algal extracts iv silicon v arbuscular mycorrhizal fungi AMF and vi plant growth promoting rhizobacteria PGPR belonging to the *Azotobacter*, *Azospirillum* and *Rhizobium* genera.
