Chinese Market Gardening in Australia and New Zealand Joanna Boileau, 2017-07-27 This book offers a fresh perspective on the Chinese diaspora. It is about the mobilisation of knowledge across time and space exploring the history of Chinese market gardening in Australia and New Zealand. BOOKJACKET Making Peoples James Belich, 2002-02-28 Now in paper This immensely readable book full of drama and humor as well as scholarship is a watershed in the writing of New Zealand history In making many new assertions and challenging many historical myths it seeks to reinterpret our approach to the past Given New Zealand's small population short history and great isolation the history of the archipelago has been saddled with a reputation for mundanity According to James Belich however it is just these characteristics that make New Zealand a historian's paradise a laboratory whose isolation size and recency is an advantage in which the grand themes of world history are often played out more rapidly more separately and therefore more discernably than elsewhere The first of two planned volumes Making Peoples begins with the Polynesian settlement and its development into the Maori tribes in the eleventh century It traces the great encounter between independent Maoridom and expanding Europe from 1642 to 1916 including the foundation of the Pakeha the neo Europeans of New Zealand between the 1830s and the 1880s It describes the forging of a neo Polynesia and a neo Britain and the traumatic interaction between them The author carefully examines the myths and realities that drove the colonialization process and suggests a new living version of one of the most critical and controversial documents in New Zealand's history the Treaty of Waitangi frequently described as New Zealand's Magna Carta The construction of peoples Maori and Pakeha is a recurring theme the response of each to the great shift from extractive to sustainable economics their relationship with their Hawai'is or ancestors with each other and with myth Essential reading for anyone interested in New Zealand history and in the history of new societies in general

Hunt, 2018 Oceania was the last region on earth to be permanently inhabited with the final settlers reaching Aotearoa New Zealand approximately AD 1300 This is about the same time that related Polynesian populations began erecting Easter Island's gigantic statues farming the valley slopes of Tahiti and similar islands and moving finely made basalt tools over several thousand kilometers of open ocean between Hawai'i the Marquesas the Cook Islands and archipelagos in between The remarkable prehistory of Polynesia is one chapter of Oceania's human story Almost 50 000 years prior people entered Oceania for the first time arriving in New Guinea and its northern offshore islands shortly thereafter a biogeographic region labelled Near Oceania and including parts of Melanesia Near Oceania saw the independent development of agriculture and has a complex history resulting in the greatest linguistic diversity in the world Beginning 1000 BC after millennia of gradually accelerating cultural change in Near Oceania some groups sailed east from this space of inter visible islands and entered Remote Oceania rapidly colonizing the widely separated separated archipelagos from Vanuatu to Samoa with purposeful return voyages and carrying an intricately decorated pottery called Lapita From this common cultural foundation these populations developed separate but occasionally connected cultural traditions over the

next 3000 years Western Micronesia the archipelagos of Palau Guam and the Marianas was also colonized around 1500 BC by canoes arriving from the west beginning equally long sequences of increasingly complex social formations exchange relationships and monumental constructions All of these topics and others are presented in The Oxford Handbook of Prehistoric Oceania written by Oceania's leading archaeologists and allied researchers Chapters describe the cultural sequences of the region's major island groups provide the most recent explanations for diversity and change in Oceanic prehistory and lay the foundation for the next generation of research
