

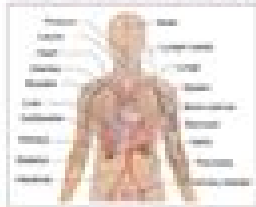

Physiology

The scientific study of the function of the human body

Structural levels

Also known as the levels of organization of the human body

- 1. Chemical level - study of the chemical composition of the body
- 2. Cellular level - study of the structure and function of cells
- 3. Tissue level - study of the structure and function of tissues
- 4. Organ level - study of the structure and function of organs
- 5. System level - study of the structure and function of body systems
- 6. Organism level - study of the structure and function of the whole body

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids

Extracellular fluid - fluid outside the cell

Intracellular fluid - fluid inside the cell

Interstitial fluid - fluid between cells

Blood plasma - fluid part of blood

Organic fluids - fluids containing organic molecules

Inorganic fluids - fluids containing inorganic molecules

Electrolytes - substances that conduct electricity

Non-electrolytes - substances that do not conduct electricity

Acids - substances that release hydrogen ions

Bases - substances that accept hydrogen ions

Salts - ionic compounds

Sugars - simple carbohydrates

Proteins - large organic molecules

Lipids - fatty acids and other organic molecules

Water - the most abundant molecule in the body

Oxygen - essential for cellular respiration

Carbon dioxide - waste product of cellular respiration

Nitrogen - essential for protein synthesis

Phosphorus - essential for energy metabolism

Potassium - essential for nerve conduction

Sodium - essential for fluid balance

Calcium - essential for bone structure

Magnesium - essential for enzyme function

Zinc - essential for immune function

Copper - essential for blood formation

Iron - essential for oxygen transport

Iodine - essential for thyroid function

Selenium - essential for antioxidant defense

Chromium - essential for insulin action

Manganese - essential for bone development

Cobalt - essential for vitamin B12 metabolism

Fluorine - essential for tooth enamel

Bromine - essential for thyroid function

Strontium - essential for bone health

Barium - essential for digestive health

Lithium - essential for mood regulation

Silver - essential for wound healing

Gold - essential for jewelry

Platinum - essential for chemotherapy

Palladium - essential for catalytic converters

Rhodium - essential for automotive catalysis
