

Anatomy of a Strong Grant Proposal

A grant proposal is a formal request for funding, submitted to a government agency, foundation, or other funding organization. It outlines a specific project or program you plan to implement, explains why it's important, and shows how the funds will be used. The goal is to convince the funder that your project is worthwhile, feasible, and aligned with their mission.



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Title Page

Clear, descriptive title outlining the project focus, location, and strategy, and the organization's name, contact information, project title, submission date, and the name of the funder.

Cover Letter

A brief letter that introduces your organization, summarizes the project's goals, and expresses appreciation for the funder's support and consideration.



Executive Summary / Abstract

A brief summary of the problem, goals, approach, expected results and qualifications.

Statement of Need / Problem Statement

Data-backed explanation of the specific issue the project will address, including root causes and urgency.



Project Objectives and Goals

Clear definition of the desired outcomes and the specific, measurable steps to achieve them.

Strategic Approach

Step-by-step method or model used to achieve the goals, including the planned activities, timeline, roles, and responsibilities.



Monitoring & Evaluation

Explanation of how you will measure progress, ensure accountability, and learn from results to improve or scale the project.

Budget & Justification

Step-by-step method or model used to achieve the goals, including the planned activities, timeline, roles, and responsibilities.



Sustainability Plan

Explanation of how the project will continue beyond the grant, through partnerships, recurring funding, or earned income.

Organizational Capacity

Overview of your organization's experience, strengths, and ability to deliver the proposed project.



Impact and Dissemination

Explanation of the expected broader impact of the project and how results will be shared.
