Hofmeyr, 2012 *Promoting sustainable local economic development initiatives* Marius Venter, 2022 This book endeavours to outline case studies that promote sustainable Local Economic Development (LED) initiatives. It is generally believed that local governments are the foot soldiers of LED. However, this seems to be a myth as local governments in South Africa and elsewhere have not yet fulfilled this mandate and have been struggling for several years to implement LED initiatives. The distinctive merit of this book lies in the way it combines the South African context with the wider international development context in ways that there is a flow of information and ideas both ways. The book is an essential part of this sequence of ideas development and action at a critical time for strategic action directed at a sustainable future. It showcases case studies and responses to the impacts of globalisation as a bridge between urban, rural and institutional action and reveals avenues for local government leadership in communities, research, student engagement and wider interactions.

Towards Employment-Intensive Growth in South Africa Anthony Black, 2016-07-01 South Africa's high rate of unemployment (26.4%) makes it a complete outlier compared with other middle income countries. Indeed, the unemployment rate rises to 36% if discouraged workers are taken into account. It underpins extreme poverty and inequality and is a major contributor to social dislocation. If it were not for increased social payments, poverty would have continued to increase since the advent of

democracy in 1994 Unemployment also represents a huge cost to growth This book focuses on the growth path of the economy The starting point is that while more rapid economic expansion is an important objective at any given level of growth the economy as a whole needs to become more labour absorbing The central question posed is how to bring about changes in the economic structure and pattern of development which would lead to the attainment of this objective The authors argue that employment needs to be much more centrally positioned within the economic and social policy arena They emphasise innovative approaches within a broader focus on the growth path and employment intensive growth And they posit that the negative impact of previous distortions requires much more than a levelling of the playing field via market based reforms Apart from presenting an alternative growth path which could start to shift the economy in new directions the book tackles themes which have received only limited attention such as wage subsidies youth unemployment and employment growth in rural areas

Rai, 2024-07-17 When thinking about the work of caring for others we often neglect the human cost born by those performing this care Feminists have long talked about the ways in which unpaid work particularly performed in the home is habitually undervalued by society but the work of caring for people both paid and unpaid can also take a toll on the health of individuals households and communities when we give more than we receive This lopsided gap between outflows and inflows as this book argues is depletion In Depletion Shirin M Rai examines the human costs of care work and how these are reproduced across the boundaries of class race gender and generation Depletion can be physical as measured

by the body mass index exhaustion sleeplessness and vital health signs It can also be mental manifesting as self doubt guilt and apprehension and the failure to take time for oneself family friends and community Moreover depletion has effects that extend well beyond the individual to households and communities Including case studies from different parts of the world and building on various methodologies Rai looks at the costs of care work or what she calls social reproduction in several forms biological reproduction unpaid work in the home and cultural and ideological work necessary to maintain social relations beyond the household Various chapters examine the costs of commuting to work and for care the value of unpaid work performed by women of different classes the costs of household work performed by children and the costs to communities when local economies are challenged by corporate interests Lastly Rai argues that depletion must be recognized in order for it to be reversed the struggles to reverse depletion are struggles for a good life generative of new imaginings of how care work both draining and joyful can be reorganized for a better future for all
