Definitions, Events, Trials and Tribulations

1491-1607

- ★ **Doctrine of Discovery**- And land not inhabited by christians was available to be discovered, claimed and exploited by christain rulers
- ★ **Social Capitalism**- structured with the ideas of liberty, equality, and justice. Values all forms of capital
- ★ **Mercantilism**- a system in which a country attempts to amass wealth through trade with other countries, exporting more than importing and increasing stores of gold
- ★ **Salutary Neglect**- British policy in colonies where trade regulations were laxly enforced and imperial supervision of colony affairs was loose
- ★ **Coronado's conquest**- spanish discovered grand canyon and several other famous landmarks in the southwest while looking for gold
- ★ **Bartolomé de las casas**- dominican missionary who was the first to expose the oppression of indigenous people by europeans and called to abolish slavery in americas
- ★ **Joint-stock company**- a company made up of a group of shareholders. If colonists buy 4 stocks, the king buys 5.
- ★ **Protestant Reformation**- a religious reform movement that swept through europe in the 1500's, separated from roman catholics, was a call to purify the church

1608-1754

- ★ Jamestown is founded in 1607
 - Failed miserably
 - First slaves are brought in 1619
- ★ **Mayflower Compact (1620)**- first document to establish self-gov't in the new world. Remained active until 1691 when plymouth colony became part of massachusetts bay
- ★ **Civil body politics**- government or law making body that comes together to honor god
- ★ **Convivence of works**- work for salvation rather than grace
 - John winthrop is a grace guy
 - **A Model of Christain Charity**- giving to others in need, for wealthy colonists charity is a measure of service to god.
