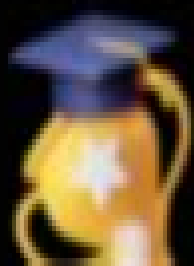
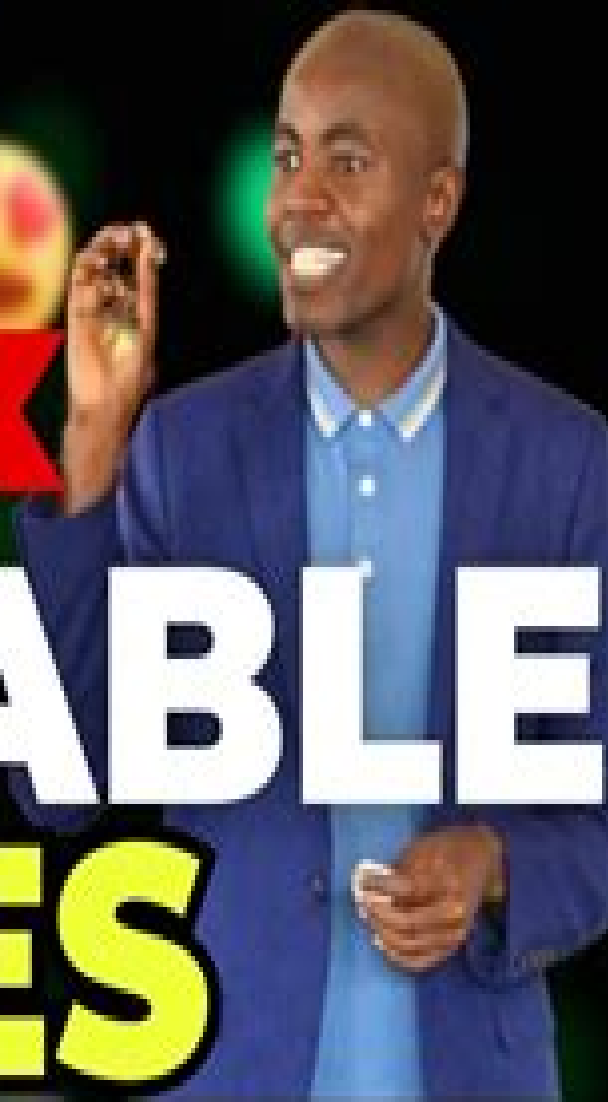


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Facing Forward Sajitha Bashir, Marlaine Lockheed, Elizabeth Ninan, Jee-Peng Tan, 2018-09-20 *Facing Forward* lays out a range of policy and implementation actions that are needed for countries in Sub Saharan Africa to meet the challenge of improving learning while expanding access and completion of basic education for all. The book underscores the importance of aligning the education system to be relentlessly focused on learning outcomes and to ensuring that all children have access to good schools, good learning materials and good teachers. It is unique in characterizing countries according to the challenges they faced in the 1990s and the educational progress they have made over the past 25 years, allowing countries in the region to learn from each other. The authors review the global literature and add to it by their extensive new analyses of multiple datasets from more than three dozen countries in the region; they integrate findings about what affects children's learning, their access to schooling and progress through basic education. The book draws lessons from the region and for the region about what works and what is needed to better implement what is known to have worked. The book examines four areas to help countries better align their systems to improve learning: 1. completing the unfinished agenda of reaching universal basic education with quality; 2. ensuring effective management and support of teachers; 3. targeting spending priorities and budget processes on improving quality; and 4. closing the institutional capacity gap. It concludes with an assessment of how future educational progress may be affected by projected fertility rates and economic growth. *Cultural*

The Malabo Agenda on Accelerated Agricultural Growth and Transformation has brought technical challenges to the development of agricultural strategies by expanding the number of commitments and goals under the Comprehensive Africa Agriculture Development Programme. In this paper, we describe and apply an economic modeling framework that was developed to identify the agricultural investment priority areas for a country and to define milestones to track its progress towards the Malabo goals. The framework consists of a three-layer simulation model that aims to capture multiple Malabo commitments and goals. First, the agricultural productivity analysis uses the stochastic meta-frontier technique to assess opportunities to increase agricultural productivity. Second, the economy-wide analysis uses an agricultural and investment-focused computable general equilibrium model to capture the Malabo goals on agricultural growth, intra-African trade of agricultural commodities, and public and private agricultural investments. Third, the microeconomic analysis builds upon statistical economic modeling to allow direct measurement and simulation of the Malabo goals on poverty and hunger. The modeling framework is applied to Kenya using the most recent data. The Malabo Agenda simulation results indicate that Kenya's current nonagriculture-led growth is not sufficient to achieving the Malabo overarching goals on poverty and hunger. Agriculture-led growth complemented by extended social assistance is more likely to close the income growth and inequality gaps and contribute to achieving the multiple Malabo commitments and goals by 2025.

Despite progress in reducing child stunting over the past 15 years, Kenya is now facing new nutrition challenges including overweight and obesity. The double burden of malnutrition (DBM), which is the coexistence of under and overnutrition within individuals, households, and populations, manifests as child stunting and adult overweight, mostly in women, at the population and household levels. Dietary diversity is low and affects different population groups, particularly young children, adolescents, and women, predisposing them to micronutrient deficiencies. However, recent data on micronutrient intake and status are lacking. Households living in urban areas are vulnerable to being overweight, a consequence of increasingly unhealthy dietary patterns. In Kenya's informal urban settlements, limited dietary diversity, reliance on cereals, and widespread consumption of ultra-processed foods (UPFs) contribute to high rates of child stunting, underweight, and the DBM, with affordability and accessibility driving food choices. Compounding factors include food safety concerns, clustering of unhealthy food vendors, and external shocks. Urban nutrition interventions have had mixed results, with some programs improving child health and maternal knowledge but others showing no significant impact. Kenya aims to eliminate malnutrition by 2027, but national policies focus mostly on rural areas, leaving urban nutrition challenges insufficiently addressed. Programs such as Afya Jiji and the Nairobi City County Food
