Anatomy and Physiology 2

Functions of the Respiratory System

- Extensive surface area for gas exchange
- Moves air to and from the exchange surfaces of lungs
- Defense (MALT)
- Producing sounds
- Facilitating the detection of olfactory stimuli by olfactory receptors

Processes of Respiration

Respiratory System vs. Cardiovascular System

- **Pulmonary ventilation (breathing)**- movement of air into and out of lungs
- **External respiration**-O₂ and CO₂ exchange between lungs and blood
- **Transport**-O₂ and CO₂ in blood
- **Internal respiration**-O₂ and CO₂ exchange between systemic blood vessels and tissues



Gross Anatomy

Upper Respiratory Tract-structures in the **head and neck**
Lower Respiratory Tract-structures in the **thoracic cavity**

Respiratory Muscles: Diaphragm and other respiratory muscles promote ventilation

Functional Anatomy

Conducting zone-conduits to gas exchange sites

- Includes all other respiratory structures; cleanses, warms, humidifies air

Respiratory zone-site of gas exchange

- Microscopic structures-respiratory **bronchioles, alveolar ducts, and alveoli**
