Chapter 19- Blood

The cardiovascular system

- Provides a mechanism for rapid transport of nutrients, waste products, respiratory gasses, and cells
- Heart, blood vessels, blood
- About 5L of blood (7% x weight in Kg (estimate))
- Closed system

Blood

- Fluid connective tissue (from the mesoderm)
- Blood cells=formed elements
 - Formed elements are cells (white blood cells and red blood cells)
- Blood+formed elements + plasma (noncellular)
 - Serum- plasma without clotting factors
- **5 functions of blood**
 - Regulate body temperature (blood is warmer than body temperature)
 - Maintain pH
 - Maintain ionic composition of the body
 - Necessary for clotting
 - Defends body from pathogens and toxins (antibodies; white blood cells)
 - Transport of nutrients, metabolic waste, and gasses
