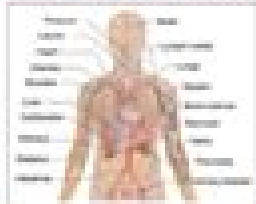
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HUMAN ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY

Study of the human organism and its internal body



Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its parts.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its parts.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves understanding the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of body systems.
- 6. **Whole body level** - study of the structure and function of the entire human body.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Intracellular fluid** - fluid inside the cell.
- 2. **Extracellular fluid** - fluid outside the cell.
- 3. **Interstitial fluid** - fluid between cells.
- 4. **Plasma** - fluid in the blood.
- 5. **Lymph** - fluid in the lymphatic system.



The **axoplasm** is the fluid inside the axon of a neuron. It is composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Neurofibrils** - protein fibers that provide structural support.
- 2. **Neurofilaments** - protein fibers that are involved in signal transmission.
- 3. **Neurotubules** - protein tubes that are involved in transport.

ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different tissues that perform a specific function.

Examples of organs include the heart, lungs, stomach, and liver.

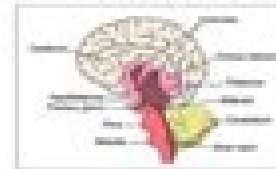
Organs are made up of different tissues, including:

- 1. **Epithelial tissue** - covers the surface of organs.
- 2. **Connective tissue** - provides structural support.
- 3. **Muscle tissue** - contracts to move organs.
- 4. **Nervous tissue** - transmits signals.

Organ systems

Organ systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a specific function.

Examples of organ systems include the digestive system and the circulatory system.



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1. **Oral cavity** - mouth and throat.

2. **Esophagus** - tube that carries food from the mouth to the stomach.

3. **Stomach** - organ that digests food.

4. **Small intestine** - long tube that absorbs nutrients from food.

5. **Large intestine** - tube that absorbs water from food.

6. **Rectum** - tube that carries waste from the large intestine to the anus.

7. **Anus** - opening at the end of the digestive tract.

NERVOUS SYSTEM

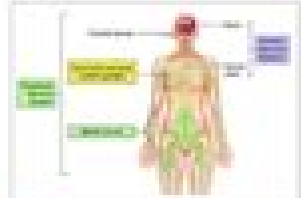
Neurons

Neurons are the basic units of the nervous system.

They are responsible for transmitting signals throughout the body.

Neurons are made up of different parts, including:

- 1. **Cell body** - contains the nucleus and other organelles.
- 2. **Dendrites** - receive signals from other neurons.
- 3. **Axon** - carries signals away from the cell body.
- 4. **Myelin sheath** - covers the axon and insulates it.
