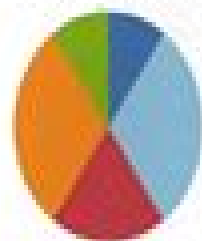

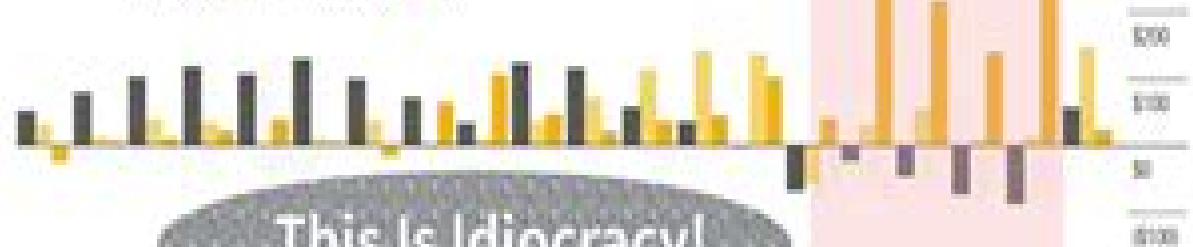

- Bond

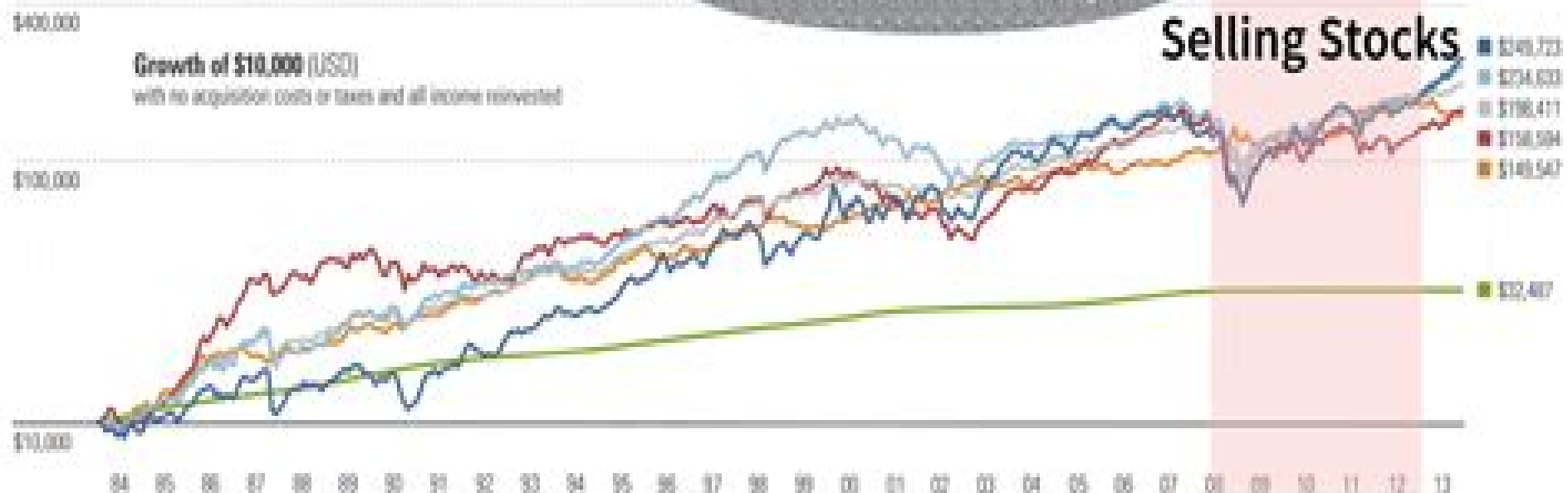
