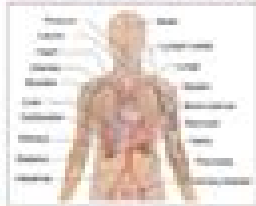
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HUMAN ANATOMY AND PHYSIOLOGY

Study of the human organism and its internal body



Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its parts.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its parts.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves understanding the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of body systems.
- 6. **Organism level** - study of the structure and function of the whole body.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body.



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Intracellular fluid** - fluid inside the cell.
- 2. **Extracellular fluid** - fluid outside the cell.
- 3. **Interstitial fluid** - fluid between cells.
- 4. **Plasma** - fluid in the blood.
- 5. **Lymph** - fluid in the lymphatic system.



The **axoplasm** is the fluid inside the axon. It is composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Neurofibrils** - protein fibers that provide structural support.
- 2. **Neurofilaments** - protein fibers that provide structural support.
- 3. **Neurotubules** - protein tubes that provide structural support.
- 4. **Neurosecretory granules** - granules that store and release hormones.

ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different tissues that perform a specific function.

Examples of organs include the heart, lungs, stomach, and liver.

Organs are made up of different tissues, including:

- 1. **Epithelial tissue** - covers the body and organs.
- 2. **Connective tissue** - supports and connects other tissues.
- 3. **Muscle tissue** - contracts to produce movement.
- 4. **Nervous tissue** - transmits information.

Organ systems

Organ systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a specific function.

Examples of organ systems include the digestive system and the circulatory system.



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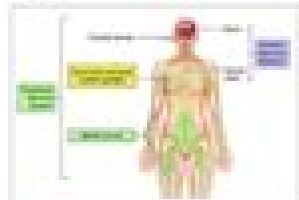
NERVOUS SYSTEM

Neurons

Neurons are the basic units of the nervous system.

They are responsible for transmitting information throughout the body.

- 1. **Cell body** - contains the nucleus and other organelles.
- 2. **Dendrites** - receive information from other neurons.
- 3. **Axon** - carries information away from the cell body.
- 4. **Myelin sheath** - insulates the axon and speeds up the transmission of information.



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NERVOUS SYSTEM

The nervous system is responsible for controlling and coordinating the body's activities.

It is made up of the brain, spinal cord, and peripheral nerves.

The brain is the control center of the nervous system.

It is responsible for processing information and making decisions.

The spinal cord is the main pathway for information between the brain and the rest of the body.

It is responsible for transmitting information between the brain and the rest of the body.

Peripheral nerves are the network of nerves that carry information between the brain, spinal cord, and the rest of the body.



Parts of neurons

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5. **Axon terminal** - releases neurotransmitters to communicate with other neurons.

6. **Synapse** - the junction between two neurons where information is passed.

7. **Neurotransmitter** - chemical messenger that carries information between neurons.

8. **Receptor** - protein on the cell membrane that binds to neurotransmitters.

9. **Ion channel** - protein in the cell membrane that allows ions to pass in and out of the cell.

10. **Cell membrane** - the boundary of the cell that separates the inside from the outside.

11. **Cytoskeleton** - the internal framework of the cell that provides structural support.

12. **Centrioles** - organelles that are involved in cell division.

13. **Lysosomes** - organelles that break down waste and cellular debris.

14. **Mitochondria** - organelles that produce energy for the cell.

15. **Rough endoplasmic reticulum** - the network of membranes that is involved in protein synthesis.

16. **Smooth endoplasmic reticulum** - the network of membranes that is involved in lipid synthesis.

17. **Golgi apparatus** - the organelle that is involved in the transport of proteins and lipids.



ORGAN SYSTEMS OF THE BODY

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Organ systems are responsible for:

- 1. **Supporting and protecting the body.**
- 2. **Transporting substances throughout the body.**
- 3. **Producing and storing energy.**
- 4. **Regulating body temperature.**
- 5. **Defending the body against disease.**
- 6. **Reproducing new cells.**
