GPU - Answer Graphics Processing Unit - dedicated graphics processor on a graphic card, used to render images stored in the RAM of the graphics card

Multi-core CPU - Answer A CPU with more than one core on the same chip - maker use of parallel processing for optimum efficiency

What affects processor performance? - Answer - The number of processor cores: more cores -> better performance

The processor's clock speed: faster clock speed -> better performance

Amount/type of cache memory: more/better cache memory -> better performance

RAM - Answer Random Access Memory - stores programs and data currently in use Volatile
