Study of the human organism and its internal body



Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its internal organs.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its internal organs.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the structural level involves understanding the following levels:

- 1. **Chemical level** - study of the chemical composition of the body.
- 2. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 3. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 4. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 5. **System level** - study of the structure and function of systems.
- 6. **Organism level** - study of the structure and function of the whole organism.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



Composition of cellular fluids

Cells are composed of various fluids, including:

- 1. **Intracellular fluid** - fluid inside the cell.
- 2. **Extracellular fluid** - fluid outside the cell.
- 3. **Interstitial fluid** - fluid between cells.
- 4. **Plasma** - fluid in the blood.
- 5. **Lymph** - fluid in the lymphatic system.

The fluid inside the cell is called intracellular fluid, and the fluid outside the cell is called extracellular fluid.

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ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different types of tissues that perform a specific function.

Examples of organs include the heart, lungs, stomach, and liver.

Organs are made up of different types of tissues, including:

- 1. **Epithelial tissue** - covers the body and organs.
- 2. **Connective tissue** - supports and connects other tissues.
- 3. **Muscle tissue** - contracts to produce movement.
- 4. **Nervous tissue** - transmits electrical signals.

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Organ systems

Organ systems are groups of organs that work together to perform a specific function.

Examples of organ systems include the digestive system, respiratory system, and circulatory system.

- 1. **Digestive system** - breaks down food into nutrients.
- 2. **Respiratory system** - takes in oxygen and releases carbon dioxide.

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NERVOUS SYSTEM

Neurons

Neurons are the basic units of the nervous system.

They are responsible for transmitting electrical signals throughout the body.

Neurons are made up of different parts, including:

- 1. **Cell body** - contains the nucleus and other organelles.
- 2. **Dendrites** - receive signals from other neurons.
- 3. **Axon** - carries signals away from the cell body.
- 4. **Myelin sheath** - insulates the axon and speeds up signal transmission.

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FUNCTIONS OF NEURONS

Neurons have several functions, including:

- 1. **Receiving signals** - receive signals from other neurons.
- 2. **Integrating signals** - integrate signals from other neurons.
- 3. **Transmitting signals** - transmit signals to other neurons.
- 4. **Controlling body functions** - control body functions.



Types of neurons

There are three main types of neurons:

- 1. **Sensory neurons** - receive signals from the environment.
- 2. **Motor neurons** - control body movements.
- 3. **Interneurons** - connect sensory and motor neurons.

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ORGAN SYSTEMS OF THE BODY

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1. **Digestive system** - breaks down food into nutrients.

2. **Respiratory system** - takes in oxygen and releases carbon dioxide.

3. **Circulatory system** - transports blood throughout the body.

4. **Excretory system** - removes waste from the body.

5. **Reproductive system** - produces offspring.

6. **Immune system** - defends the body against disease.

7. **Endocrine system** - controls body functions.

8. **Nervous system** - controls body movements.

9. **Musculoskeletal system** - supports and moves the body.

10. **Integumentary system** - covers the body and protects it from the environment.

11. **Urinary system** - filters waste from the blood.

12. **Reproductive system** - produces offspring.
