The Holocaust Museum and Human Rights Jennifer Barrett, Avril Alba, Dirk Moses, 2025-01-28 Interrogates the global and often controversial phenomenon of Holocaust and human rights museums Spanning six continents Europe Australia Africa Asia North America and South America this edited collection offers a comparative transnational study of Holocaust and human rights museums that foregrounds the overlapping and often contested work these institutions do in narrating and memorializing histories of genocide and human rights abuses for a public audience Museums that link the Holocaust with social justice human rights and genocide prevention have been
