Extractive Industry Indigenisation in Zimbabwe Kennedy Manduna, 2025-09-25 This book explains how and why

Zimbabwe s extractive industry Indigenisation over promised its benefits yet under delivered upon implementation This book

traces the history of uneven development in Zimbabwe from the initial days of colonialism to the present using the extractive industry as the unit of analysis to carve out a granular and empirical analysis of the preponderance of transnational corporate control and ownership in the country. Indigenisation of Zimbabwe's extractive industries was intended to address mining inequalities by transferring wealth from rich non-Indigenous mining capital to disadvantaged Indigenous citizens and communities. This policy, however, was a response to political, economic and social crises posed by the international isolation of Zimbabwe's government following the controversial Fast Track Land Reform Programme in 2000-2003. An intervention, therefore, which promised to address inequalities has thus been hampered by corruption, co-optation and collusion, which has led to it not only failing to address uneven development but in actual fact worsening the situation. By examining the hidden structures and infrastructures of power, capital and minerals, and placing extractive industry indigenisation in capitalism, this book makes a crucial scholarly contribution to the renewed and burgeoning debates around the resurgence of resource nationalism in general and the struggle for economic sovereignty in particular. This book steers readers more broadly to look for new and diversified ways of empowering Indigenous populations and their communities through mining indigenisation in ways that do not threaten economic and political stability. This book will be of great interest to students and scholars of the extractive industries, natural resource management, African politics and African development.

Zimbabwe is advancing climate change adaptation in its livestock sector with key strategies reflected in both its initial and updated nationally determined contributions (NDCs). Although various climate-smart practices are already being implemented through livestock support programs, their contributions to adaptation and mitigation remain largely undocumented, resulting in their omission from the NDCs. To address this, the Department of Livestock Research has introduced a Tier 2 greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory for cattle, allowing for more accurate assessments of mitigation potential and informing the 2025 NDC update. This report brings together insights from literature reviews, policy analysis and stakeholder consultations to evaluate the current policy landscape for livestock-related climate action. It highlights the sector's growing vulnerability to climate change, including feed scarcity, disease outbreaks and declining productivity. The report identifies key policy gaps and stresses the importance of capacity building, data-driven planning and inclusive engagement to enhance climate resilience and reduce emissions in the livestock sector.

Digital Activism in Zimbabwe Tenford Chitanana, 2024-10-21 This book investigates the role of the internet and social media in political processes in non western and non democratic contexts Using Zimbabwe as a case study the book demonstrates how activists and ordinary people deploy social media particularly Facebook to subvert an enduring hegemonic state However the book also highlights how authoritarian regimes are in turn learning and adapting to the information age challenging the impact of digital activism Studies of digital activism in the Global South are often centred around democracy but this book paints a more complex picture examining the role and effect of digital activism in challenging state hegemony in authoritarian contexts The book notes that while communication technologies help mediate

activism they are also simultaneously constrained by pre existing and emergent challenges tied to the social and political context and the inherent limitations of those technologies The book investigates the tactics used by digital activists the contextual factors and restrictive political environment they operate in including the role of pro government activists and ultimately the impact of digital activism given these constraints From the case of Zimbabwe the book builds out a broader theoretical analysis of the evolution of third world protest in the digital age examining the limitations of activists actions and the ideological deficit in online activism to ferment a virulent counter hegemony

The Sustainability Ethic in the Management of the Physical, Infrastructural and Natural Resources of Zimbabwe Chirisa, Innocent, 2019-05-27

Humanity has extensively exploited natural and physical resources since the Industrial Revolution in Europe A geological era now called the Anthropocene has been coined in environmental and developmental circles to mark the increased domination of humanity on Earth and its resources Today the ecological footprint on the fragile planet continues to increase Mass industrialisation like what China is doing and pushing for is one of the drivers for increased urbanisation that results in increased demand for land It is also the stimulus behind increased deforestation overfishing and pollution As the fragility of the Earth increases global bodies like the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change are pushing to reduce the Earth s temperature Human efforts to manage the problem cascade from a global to a regional to a national as well as to much localised scales Missing though are nuanced contributions at national and community levels which this book is an attempt to bridge The nagging sense of responsibility is what this book explores under the label of sustainability ethic As a case study the book examines the use of sustainability ethic in the management of the physical infrastructural and natural resources of Zimbabwe This ethic is built on pillars that include participation of people households in their pursuit for sustainable livelihoods appropriate technology tools and techniques for environmental protection It also hinges on stewardship and structures institutions policies and processes of governance and sustainability There are also the aspects of ethics laws and indigenous technical knowledge for sustainability capacity building and education plans and programmes for sustainability and population and demographic determinants processes and outcomes for sustainability The book is a timely contribution to an urgent global concern and climate change debate

Building from the Rubble Lloyd Sachikonye, Brian Raftopoulos, 2018-09-23 Building from the Rubble is the latest volume to trace the history of Zimbabwes labour movement following Keep on Knocking 1997 and Striking Back 2001 Even though it focuses on the period between 2000 2017 the analysis reviews the changes in trade unionism throughout the post colonial era For much of this period the unions faced massive challenges including state violence and repression funding limitations splits factionalism and problems of organising at factory level Perhaps the greatest challenge was the massive structural change in the economy Deindustrialisation and the informalisation of work decimated the potential membership of the unions and redefined the trajectory of the movement The growing precarity of work and the loss of formal employment placed the future of trade unions in great jeopardy

Notwithstanding these challenges the importance of the labour movement continued to resonate with workers The editors conclude that the unions needs to reconnect with their social base at the workplace and rebuild structures and alliances in the informal economy the rural sector and with residents associations and social media movements This they write is a critical post Mugabe agenda that should be seized by the labour movement at all levels from shop floor to district regional and national spaces
