Faith of Cranes Hank Lentfer, 2011-08-29 Faith of Cranes weaves together three parallel narratives the plight and beauty of sandhill cranes one man's effort to recover hope amid destructive climate change and the birth of a daughter [CLICK HERE](#) to download the first chapter from Faith of Cranes Faith of Cranes is a love song to the beauty and worth of the lives we are able to lead in the world just as it is troubled though it be Lentfer's storytelling achieves its joys and universality not via grand summations but via grounded self-giving familial intimacy funny friendships attentive griefs and full-bodied immersion in the Alaskan rainforest The writing is honest intensely lived and overflowing with heart broken mended and whole David James Duncan author of The Brothers K and God Laughs Plays Hank Lentfer listened to cranes passing over his home in southeast Alaska for twenty years before bothering to figure out where they were going On a very visceral level he didn't want to know After all cranes gliding through the wide skies of Alaska are the essence of wildness But the same animals pecking a living between the cornfields and condos of California's Central Valley seem trapped and diminished A former wildlife biologist and longtime conservationist Lentfer had come to accept that no number of letters to the editor or trips to D.C. could stop the spread of clear cuts alter the course of climate change or ensure that his beloved cranes would always appear And he had no idea that following the paths of cranes would lead him to the very things he was most afraid of parenthood responsibility and actions of hope in a frustrating and warming world Faith of Cranes is Lentfer's quiet lyrical memoir of his home and community near Glacier Bay that reveals a family's simple acts planting potatoes watching cranes hunting deer as well as a close and eccentric Alaskan community It shows how several thousand birds and one little girl teach a new father there is no future imaginable that does not leave room for compassion and grace [Proceedings RMRS.](#), 1998 *The Wilderness Debate Rages on* Michael P. Baird Callicott, 2008 Ten years ago The Great New Wilderness Debate began a cross-disciplinary conversation about the varied constructions of wilderness and the controversies that surround them The Wilderness Debate Rages On will reinvigorate that conversation and usher in a second decade of debate Like its predecessor the book gathers both critiques and defenses of the idea of wilderness from a wide

variety of perspectives and voices The Wilderness Debate Rages On includes the best explorations of the concept of the concept of wilderness from the past decade underappreciated essays from the early twentieth century that offer an alternative vision of the concept and importance of wilderness and writings meant to clarify or help us rethink the concept of wilderness Narrative writers such as Wendell Berry Scott Russell Sanders Marilynne Robinson Kathleen Dean Moore and Lynn Maria Laitala are also given a voice in order to show how the wilderness debate is expanding outside the academy The writers represented in the anthology include ecologists environmental philosophers conservation biologists cultural geographers and environmental activists The book begins with little known papers by early twentieth century ecologists advocating the preservation of natural areas for scientific study not as did Thoreau Muir and the early Leopold for purposes of outdoor recreation The editors argue that had these writers influenced the eventual development of federal wilderness policy our national wilderness system would better serve contemporary conservation priorities for representative ecosystems and biodiversity

North to Katahdin Eric Pinder, 2005 When Thoreau ventured into the Maine woods in 1846 he was one of a handful who did so simply to see what was there Now hundreds of thousands of people pursue the wildest country either for itself as Thoreau did or as the terminus of the Appalachian Trail Using Mount Katahdin as his lab Eric Pinder contemplates what draws people to the mountains Are the urbanites trekking the trails with cell phones synthetic fabrics and GPS units having remotely the same experience that Thoreau did Pinder's interviews with these hikers create a vivid portrait of the communion with nature they seek and of the world they are trying to escape

Wilderness in the Circumpolar North, 2002 There are growing pressures on undeveloped wild places in the Circumpolar North Among them are pressures for economic development oil and gas exploration and extraction development of geothermal energy resources development of heavy industry close to energy sources and lack of appreciation for other orientations toward wilderness resources by interested parties from broad geographical origins An international seminar in Anchorage Alaska in May of 2001 was the first step in providing basic input to an analysis of the primary set of values associated with Circumpolar North wilderness and the constraints and contributors factors of influence that either limit or facilitate receipt of those values to various segments of society
