moisture variations Indeed all these rely on the explosive use of big data in many fields of human endeavour Moreover with the ever increasing global population intense pressure is being exerted on the Earth's resources leading to significant changes in its land cover e.g. deforestation diminishing biodiversity and natural habitats dwindling fresh water supplies and changing weather and climatic patterns e.g. global warming changing sea level Environmental monitoring techniques that provide information on these are under scrutiny from an increasingly environmentally conscious society that demands the efficient delivery of such information at a minimal cost Environmental changes vary both spatially and temporally thereby putting pressure on traditional methods of data acquisition some of which are highly labour intensive such as animal tracking for conservation purposes With these challenges conventional monitoring techniques particularly those that record spatial changes call for more sophisticated approaches that deliver the necessary information at an affordable cost One direction being pursued in the development of such techniques involves environmental geoinformatics which can act as a stand alone method or complement traditional methods
