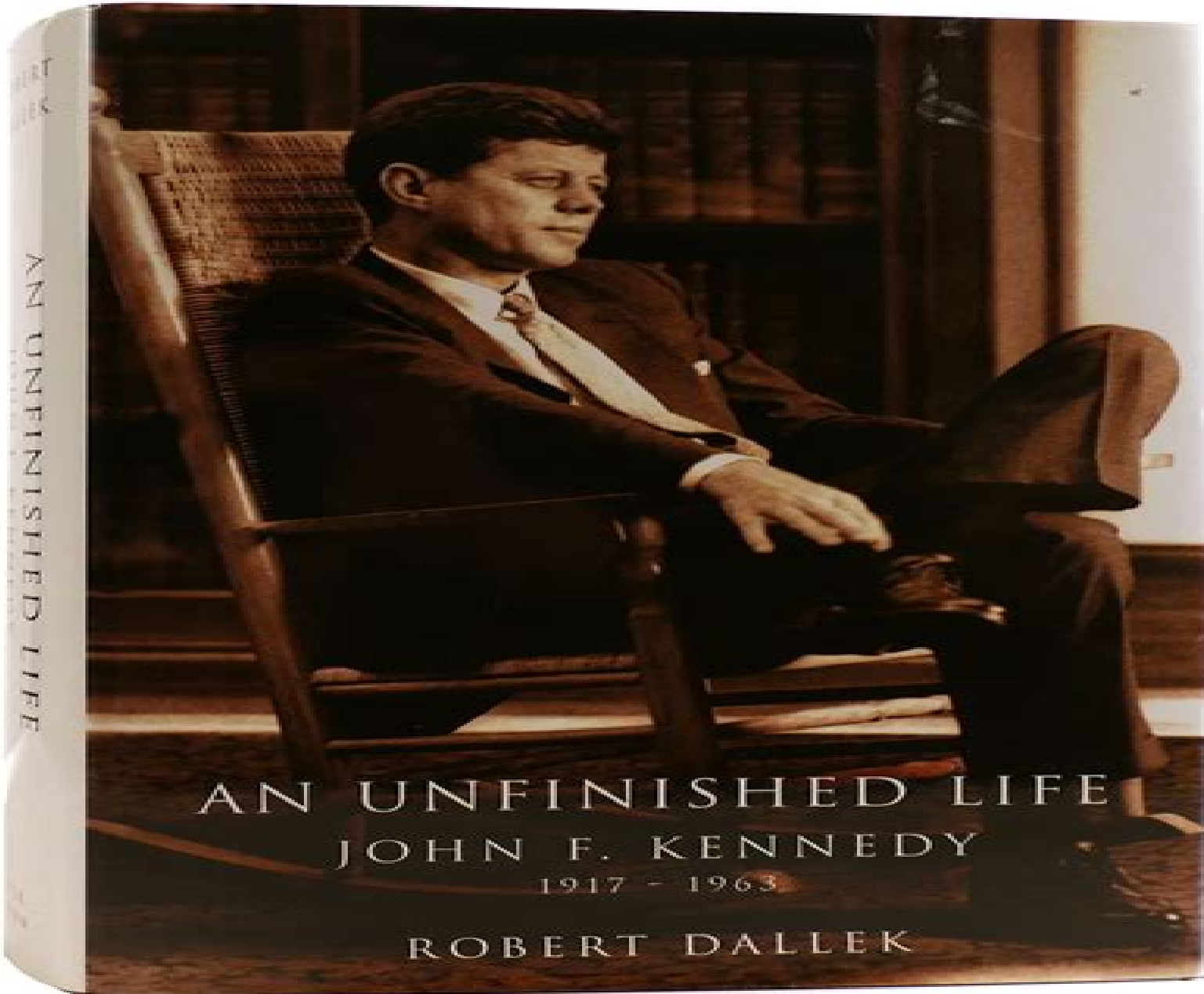

the literature on Cuba and establishes for the first time the integral extensive role of mobsters in the Cuban exile movement. The narrative unfolds against a broader historical backdrop of which it was a part: the confrontation between the United States and the Cuban revolution which turned Cuba into one of the most perilous battlegrounds of the Cold War. The anti-communist hysteria generated by the Cold War frequently unhinged the policy judgments of US government officials in many areas but nowhere so completely as in our relations with Cuba. This conclusion is inescapable as *Gangsterismo* brilliantly unravels the bizarre tale of the Mafia army the Kennedy brothers recruited in their manic determination to rid Cuba of Castro that vexing seemingly indomitable Communist Martin J.
