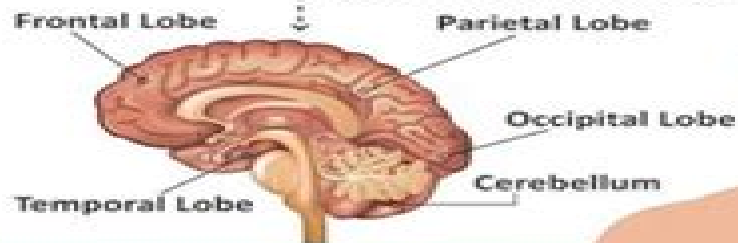
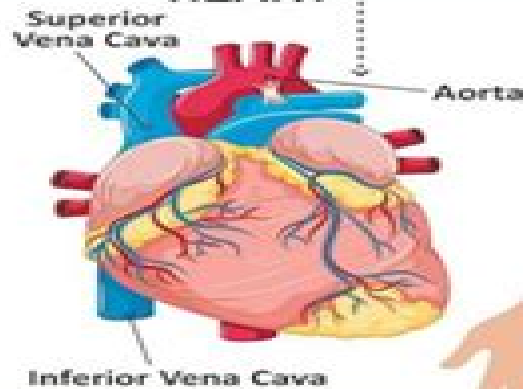


BRAIN

HEART



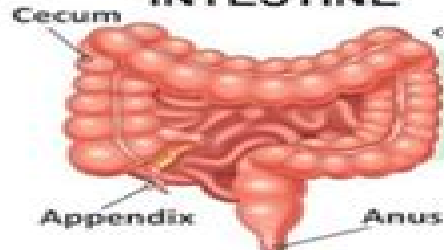
Pumps blood around the body.

STOMACH



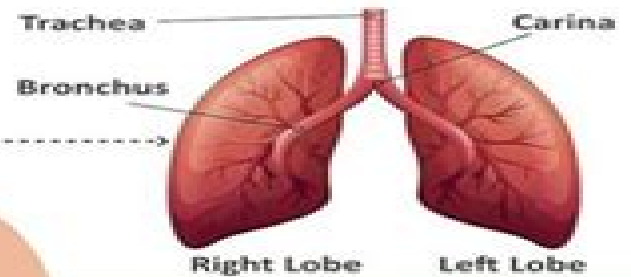
Helps in the breakage of food.

INTESTINE



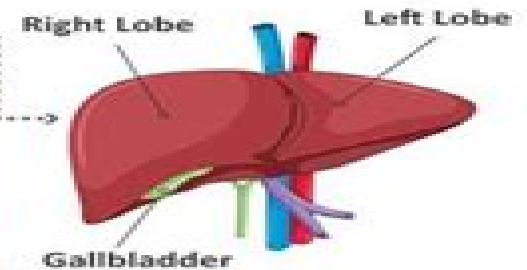
Helps in the digestion of food.

LUNGS



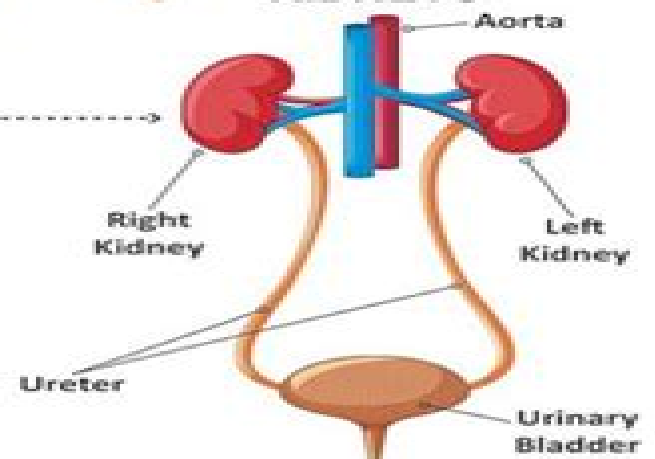
Helps to breathe.
