- Anterior (ventral): Anterior means towards the front ex) the mammary glands are anterior to the chest wall
- Posterior (dorsal): posterior means towards the back ex) The esophagus is posterior to the trachea
- Cranial (cephalad): Cranial means towards the head. Cranial is synonymous with superior ex) The thoracic cavity lies cephalad (superior) to the abdominopelvic cavity
- Medial; Medial means nearest the midline of the body ex) The nose is in a medial position on the face
