

Methods could include: advertising in local papers OR local television, leaflets, mailshots to customer base, free food samples, discount vouchers, competitions.

(c) Identify and explain two factors that would affect Kyle's choice of source of finance. [4]

Relevant points might include: • Amount needed he has some savings so might not need much money • What finance is needed for as would use different sources for buying ingredients or the shop • Timespan to buy ingredients is likely to be short term /if to buy franchise – long term so he needs to decide how • Financial status as just starting to trade he will not have many options • Interest rates if high, likely to have to pay a lot if borrow \$100000

(d) Identify and explain two factors that Kyle should consider when choosing a suitable location for his business. [6]

Factors could include: • Demand/customers: enough people to have sale/revenue • Cost of rent a busy city centre location will cost more which as new cannot afford • Competition: if other fast food businesses nearby customers might be loyal to them so will not chose Frydays • Guidelines from Frydays could state where restaurant has to be so has little choice • Access to right type of employees as needs to hire employees • Enough space as needs somewhere to cook as well as serve • Space for parking so ease of access for food deliveries

(e) Do you think that owning a franchise would mean Kyle is 'certain to make a profit?' Justify your answer. [6]

Relevant points might include: • Has to give royalties/share of profits to Frydays so little profit for himself • Less risk than sole trader so higher possible sales/customers as its leading name • Total costs might be too high • Franchisor will pay for some costs, e.g. promotion reducing Kyle's fixed costs • Limited influence over decisions so not able to make choices to increase sales enough • Negative publicity about Frydays will affect all franchises so sales and profits could suffer through no fault of Kyle • Customer tastes might change so demand for fast food falls • Actions of competitors so sales might fall • Business is not guaranteed to succeed if he chooses the wrong location; might not make enough sales / get customers

5 (a) Identify two features of an economic boom.

Points might include: Low unemployment, high GDP, rising business sector profits, rising rates of inflation, (possible) shortage of skilled workers, business costs rising, higher demand, higher incomes.

(b) Identify two possible advantages to mine workers of being members of a trade union. [2]

Points could include: negotiate for higher wages, better working conditions, improved health and safety, collective bargaining power, advice, legal support, social benefits.

(c) Identify and explain two possible advantages to GGC's management of its mine workers of being members of a trade union. [4]

Points might include: • Disputes can be solved more quickly so mining operations are not delayed • Help agree changes, e.g. if union agree to longer shifts miners are likely to accept the change • No need to negotiate with individual workers • Less time wasted in arguments so managers can

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The Importance Of Iron In Pathophysiologic Conditions Raffaella Gozzelino, Paolo Arosio, 2015-06-09 The iron element Fe is strictly required for the survival of most forms of life including bacteria plants and humans Fine tuned regulatory mechanisms for Fe absorption mobilization and recycling operate to maintain Fe homeostasis the disruption of which leads to Fe overload or Fe depletion Whereas the deleterious effect of Fe deficiency relies on reduced oxygen transport and diminished activity of Fe dependent enzymes the cytotoxicity induced by Fe overload is due to the ability of this metal to act as a pro oxidant and catalyze the formation of highly reactive hydroxyl radicals via the Fenton chemistry This results in unfettered oxidative stress generation that by inducing protein lipid and DNA oxidation leads to Fe mediated programmed cell death and organ dysfunction Major and systemic Fe overloads occurring in hemochromatosis and Fe loading anemias have been extensively studied However localized tissue Fe overload was recently associated to a variety of pathologies such as infection inflammation cancer cardiovascular and neurodegenerative disorders In keeping with the existence of cross regulatory interactions between Fe homeostasis and the pathophysiology of these diseases further investigations on the mechanisms that provide cellular and systemic adaptation to tissue Fe overload are instrumental for future therapeutic approaches Thus we encourage our colleagues to submit original research papers reviews perspectives methods and technology reports to contribute their findings to a current state of the art on a comprehensive overview of the importance of iron metabolism in pathophysiologic conditions
