Foreign Direct Investment in Agriculture Jan Schüpbach, 2015-10-07 Foreign direct investment in agriculture and land has increased substantially since the 2007 2008 food price crisis However there is a severe lack of quantitative evidence on its economic impact Therefore the primary goal of this study was to collect and analyze empirical evidence in order to better understand the potential benefits and pitfalls of such investments and related processes of agricultural commercialization In particular the study tests the effect of two strategies for including smallholder farmers into modern food supply chains 1 Outgrower schemes i e a type of contract farming whereby small scale farmers produce crops for large scale farming enterprises 2 Wage employment on large scale estates The central part of the study looks at one specific investment project in the Zambian sugar cane sector This sectoral focus was supplemented by a broader cross sectoral analysis of a large nationally representative panel survey Overall the evidence suggests that large scale investments by foreign as well as domestic companies and especially the model of cooperation with smallholder farmers in outgrower schemes can indeed have positive and significant effects on the income and wealth of rural households **Routledge**

Development of agricultural mechanization in Ghana Cossar, Frances, Houssou, Nazaire, Asante-Addo, Collins, 2016-05-06 This paper characterizes the network of tractor service providers in Ghana Using the case of Ejura Sekye dumase district this research examines the implications of the adoption of mechanical technology in agriculture for farmers and institutions based on perspectives that go beyond the suppliers and users of mechanization services alone The results suggest that in addition to rising population density and favorable access to local and regional markets the current pattern of use of tractors by farmers in Ejura district emerged from favorable historical and institutional factors The current arrangement involving a network of private tractor owners providing tractor hire services to a broad set of farmers draws upon the legacy of an earlier institutional intervention and is sustained organizationally through kinship and other existing social relationships within and outside the district Moreover the expansion of tractor use has created a set of new roles and relationships within the network Participation in the network is affected by various factors including farmer's access to capital and knowledge experience and contacts This privately operated network is significantly more efficient and provides small scale farmers with considerably better access to plowing service than did previous government managed systems Further development of the tractor service sector is likely to improve the quality of mechanization offered to smallholder farmers enhance bargaining power for farmers seeking such services and reduce structural weaknesses within the network Cyanobacteria and

is significantly associated with successful transition of small scale farmers rather than entry of medium or large farms into agriculture reflecting small scale farmers successfully breaking through the barriers of subsistence agriculture into more commercialized production systems The findings in this paper also suggest that some of the factors thought to be important for change in farm structure are no obstacle to farm size growth even though they may foster transition Notably the results here diverge from the patterns observed in Zambia and Kenya which indicate that the emergent farmers came mostly from the urban elite Unfortunately past and current policy discussions have not featured these emergent farmers sufficiently in the quest to transform agriculture in Ghana Government should capitalize on these emergent farmers who have a demonstrated ability to graduate productively as it strives to address challenges in the smallholder sector **Official**

Meade, 2015-07-22 The world's population is predicted to hit 9 Billion by 2050 and with it food demand is predicted to increase substantially The World Bank estimates that cereal and meat production needs to increase by 50% and 85% respectively between 2000 and 2030 to meet demand putting serious pressure on the global agricultural industry Critical to meeting this demand for food are mechanisms to reduce the incidence of animal disease With in excess of 1.3 billion cattle globally the total cost of infectious diseases is difficult to estimate However in North America alone the cost is predicted to be 18 billion annually Non infectious diseases also account for another major impediment to the production capacity and welfare of animals as well as the economic sustainability of farming However animal diseases have implications that spread far beyond the farm gate Infectious agents can also contaminate the food chain and potentially affect human health Controlling diseases through better preventative and treatment methods requires a detailed understanding of the immune response in livestock species Multiple studies have identified associations between variation in immune genes and disease susceptibility which potentially opens up new avenues to select animals with superior disease resistance Detailed understanding of immunity in cattle is leading to the design of more effective vaccines Furthermore appreciation of the significant differences between rodent and human immune responses has also led to bovine models being developed for some human diseases The publication of the bovine genome and the advent of next generation sequencing technologies have facilitated a massive expansion in our knowledge of the immune response in cattle As a result there has been an explosion of exciting research findings including in metagenomics and epigenetics Recently there has been a welcome move to integrate our emerging understanding of the immune response with detailed studies of other important physiological processes including nutrition and reproduction The interactions between the reproductive system nutrition and the immune system are of particular interest since each places significant demands on the animal at various stages through the production cycle The interplay between these morphologically diffuse systems involves widely distributed chemical signals in response to environmental input and each system must interact for the normal functioning of the other A comprehensive systems approach is improving our understanding of normal physiological interactions between these systems and furthermore how dysregulation can lead to disease The successful translation of bovine immunological research into improved treatments for animal disease requires tight interaction between diverse scientific and clinical disciplines including immunology microbiology endocrinology physiology nutrition reproduction and clinical veterinary medicine With so much recent progress in the field we believe that it is valuable and well timed to review the broad variety of the relevant studies that attempt to increase our understanding through comprehensive collaboration between these disciplines We are looking forward to a wide and vivid discussion of developments in bovine immunology and related issues and we expect that our readers profoundly
