1. Distribution - delevering 02 and nutrients to body cells; transporting metabolic wastes to lungs and kidneys for climination; transporting hormones from endoexine organs to target organs

2. Kegulation maintaining body temp by abombers and distributing heat; maintaining normal PH buyers maintaining accounts fluid idume in circulatory system

3. perstection - graventing blood loss - plasma proteins and platelels - dot formation; graventing injection
