The walk without limbs: Searching for indigenous health knowledge in a rural context in South Africa Gubela Mji, Melanie Alperstein, Nondwe Bongokazi Mlenzana, Karen Galloway, Chioma Ohajunwa, Lieketseng Ned, Ntombekhaya Tshabalala, 2019-12-12 In a country as diverse as South Africa sickness and health often mean different things to different people so much so that the different health definitions and health belief models in the country seem to have a profound influence on the health seeking behaviour of the people who are part of our vibrant multicultural society This book is concerned with the integration of indigenous health knowledge IHK into the current Western orientated Primary Health Care PHC model The first section of the book highlights the challenges facing the training of health professionals using a curriculum that is not drawing its knowledge base from the indigenous context and the people of that context Such professionals will later recognise that they are walking without limbs in matters pertaining to health The area that was chosen for conducting the research was KwaBomvana in Xhosa Elliotdale Eastern Cape province South Africa The people who reside there are called AmaBomvana The area where the Bomvana peoples reside is served by Madwaleni Hospital and eight surrounding clinics Qualitative ethnographic feminist methods of data collection supported the

research done for Section 1 of the book Section 2 comprises the translation and implementation of PhD study outcomes and had contributions from various researchers In the critical research findings of the PhD study older Xhosa women identify the inclusion of social determinants of health as vital to the health problems they managed within their homes For them each disease is linked to a social determinant of health and the management of health problems includes the management of social determinants of health For them it is about the health of the home and not just about the management of disease They believe that healthy homes make healthy villages and that the prevention of the development of disease is related to the strengthening of the home Health and illness should be seen within both physical and spiritual contexts without health there can be no progress in the home When defining health the older Xhosa women add three critical components to the WHO health definition namely food security healthy children and families and peace and security in their villages Prof Mji further proposes that these three elements should be included in the next revision of the WHO health definition because they are not only important for the Bomvana people where the research was conducted but also for the rest of humanity In light of the promise of National Health Insurance and the revitalisation of PHC this book proposes that these two major national health policies should take cognisance of the IHK utilised by the older Xhosa women In addition to what this research implies these policies should also take note of all IHK from the indigenous peoples of South Africa Africa and the rest of the world and that there should be a clear plan as to how the knowledge can be supported within a health care systems approach

Oriola, 2016-05-13 Crude oil extraction in the Niger Delta region of Nigeria generates 96% of all foreign earnings and 85% of state revenues making it crucial to the survival of the Nigerian state Several generations of state neglect corruption and

mismanagement have ensured that the Delta region is one of the most socio economically and politically deprived in the country By the late 1990s there was a frightening proliferation of armed gangs and insurgent groups Illegal oil bunkering pipeline vandalism disruption of oil production activities riots and demonstrations intensified and in 2003 insurgents began kidnapping oil workers at a frenetic pace In late 2005 an uber insurgent movement organization was formed in Nigeria Christened the Movement for the Emancipation of the Niger Delta MEND it operates as an amorphous multifaceted amalgam of insurgent groups with an unprecedented clinical precision in execution of intents By focussing on kidnappings that are putatively connected to the struggle for emancipating the Niger Delta Oriola makes the case for analysing MEND as a social movement organization rather than a terrorist or criminal gang by showing how political processes shape kidnappings in the Delta The use of violent repertoires of contention has not garnered sufficient attention in the social movement literature despite the fact that that around the world many similar groups are adopting violent tactics without necessarily eschewing non violent techniques Based on multi actor research including interviews and focus group discussions with community members military authorities 42 ex insurgents directly involved in illegal oil bunkering and kidnapping and official email statements from Jomo Gbomo the spokesperson of MEND this book will be of interest to sociologists political scientists and peace and security studies scholars

Policy, Media, and the Shaping of Spain-Morocco Relations Farah Ali, 2024-07-20 This book uses sociolinguistic approaches to explore how media discourse on undocumented migration informs Morocco Spain political relations Historically much of the contact between these two nations has been through conquest first through the Umayyad Caliphate taking control of the Iberian Peninsula then called Hispania in the 8th century and then through Spain's occupation of northern Morocco in the 20th century Though these historical roots have undoubtedly played a role in shaping present day Morocco Spain relations migration has also become another critical element as the majority of legally authorized migration to Spain comes from Morocco Additionally Morocco serves as a sojourn for much of the undocumented migration to the Spanish autonomous cities of Ceuta and Melilla both of which are enclaves in Morocco and common entry points for North African and Sub Saharan African immigrants Migration to Ceuta and Melilla has therefore become a flashpoint for anti immigration attitudes that are frequently perpetuated in political and media discourse The author uses these cities as a case study situating them within the wider context of both immigration related policies and news articles in order to examine how migration is represented in Spain and Morocco The book connects media discourse with policy discourse and addresses how these mediums 1 co construct anti immigration and xenophobic ideologies and 2 shape and are shaped by the somewhat
