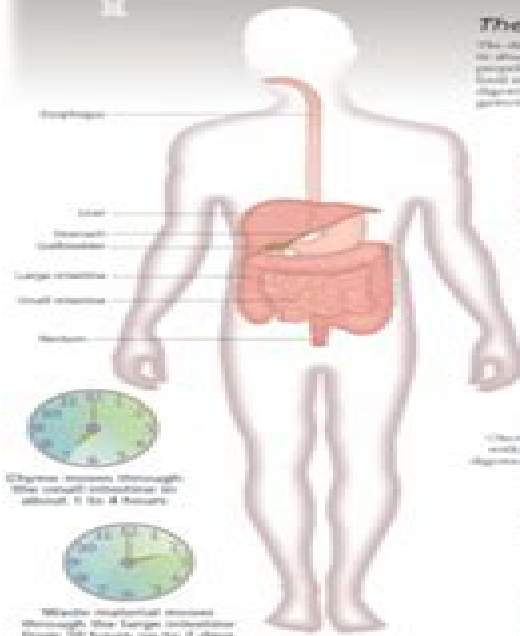




The Digestive Process

The digestive system

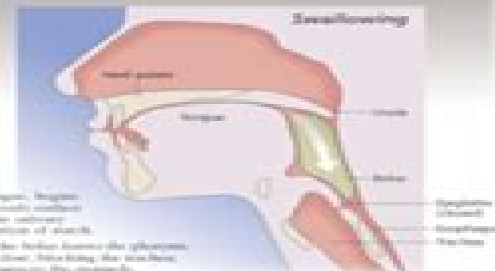
The digestive system, or gastrointestinal tract, is essentially a muscular tube in which food is broken down by the action of enzymes and chemical substances. Food enters the mouth, is chewed, and is propelled through a series of different accessory and absorptive components. Within these components, food is digested (broken down) by digestive enzymes and components must arrange to be absorbed. The digestive system also stores undigested components until they are ready to be expelled at the end of the gastrointestinal tract.



Ingestion

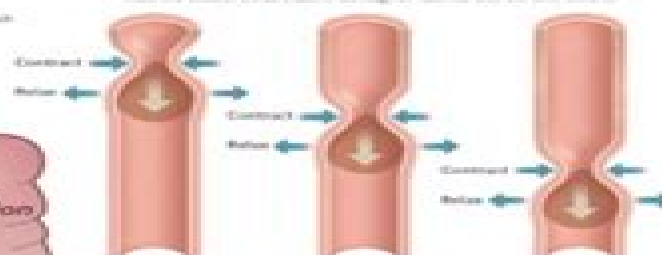
Chewing & swallowing

Chewing, the mechanical action of the mouth and tongue, begins the breakdown of solid food. This greatly increases food's surface area and exposes the food to the action of the salivary glands. Saliva contains the food and begins the digestion of starch. The mixture of food and saliva is called a *bolus*. In the bolus, the pharynx, the esophagus, a flap-like valve, and the vocal cord contract, forcing the bolus forward, where it moves into the stomach through the esophagus.



Peristaltic action

Material is moved through the digestive system by a series of muscle contractions called peristalsis. The muscle is relaxed in the material contents, while the muscle above contracts, forcing the material into the next section.

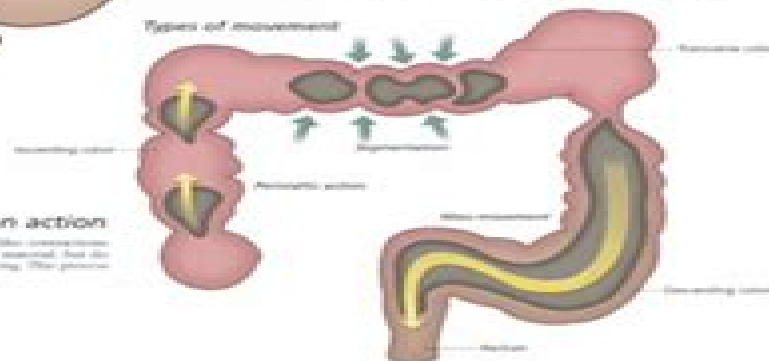


In the peristaltic action, material moves through the large intestine, where absorption is almost total. The remaining waste is moved forward and expelled.

Colonic movement

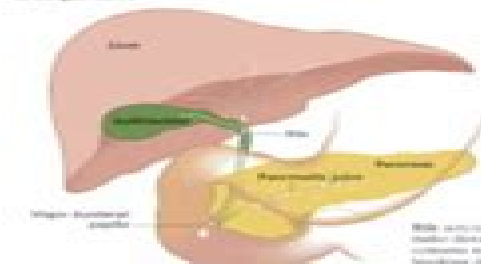
Movement through the large intestine is accomplished through the contractions of the longitudinal and circular muscles. Types of movement include peristaltic action, segmental action, and mass movement. Movement of food through the large intestine is slower than through the small intestine, allowing for absorption of water.

Types of movement

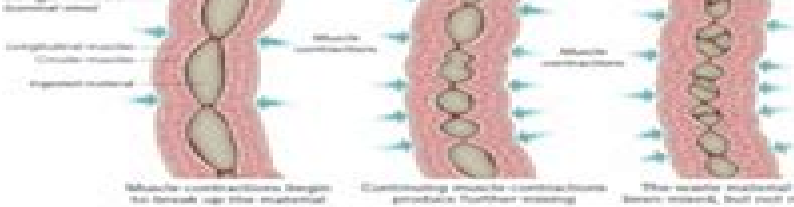


Segmentation action

In regular intervals, ring-like contractions (called segmentation) occur and mix the waste material. This is the most common type of movement in the large intestine.

Muscle contractions begin to break up the material. Continuing muscle contractions produce further mixing. The waste material has been mixed, but not moved.
