Samuel, 2015-11 American history is ubiquitous underscoring everything from food to travel to architecture and design It is also emotionally charged frequently crossing paths with political and legal issues In Remembering America Lawrence R Samuel examines the place that American history has occupied within education and popular culture and how it has continually shaped and reflected our cultural values and national identity The story of American history Samuel explains is not a straight line but rather one filled with twists and turns and ups and downs its narrative path as winding as that of the United States as a whole Organized around six distinct eras of American history ranging from the 1920s to the present Samuel shows that our understanding of American history has often generated struggle and contention as ideologically opposed groups battled over ownership of the past As women and minorities gained greater power and a louder voice in the national conversation our perspectives on American history became significantly
