1. The general anatomical features of the digestive tube are listed below. Fill in the table to complete the information.

2. The tubelike digestive system canal that extends from the mouth to the anus is the alimentary canal.
3. How is the muscularis externa of the stomach modified? It has a third, obliquely oriented muscle layer.

How does this modification relate to the function of the stomach? Digested churning activity occurs here.

4. What transition in epithelium type exists at the gastroesophageal junction? Changes from stratified squamous (esophagus) to simple columnar (stomach).

How do the epithelia of these two organs relate to their specific functions? The esophagus is subjected to constant abrasion (stratified squamous is well adapted for this). The stomach has secretory (and some absorptive) functions.

5. Differentiate between the colon and the large intestine. The large intestine includes the colon, but also includes the cecum, vermiform appendix, rectum, and anal canal.
