In response, multiple countries in Europe had to rebuild their economies back from nothing. In Germany, Hitler completely changed the Germans government from practicing communism, to now practicing fascism. Fascism was the idea of a dictator promising citizens into thinking that good days will come again and fast when in reality it most likely is impossible. Hitler was a very powerful leader and wanted only the best for himself rather than his country. In response to Hitler, France and Great Britain practiced appeasement to avoid war, but it only lasted for so long. France and Great Britain realized that Hitler would never be satisfied and decided to finally fight back. So, Hitler changed Germany's government from communism to fascism to rise out of the Great Depression and on top of the world.

Hitler created Nazi Germany and expected everything to be perfect. He expected to keep the idea from communism that he ruled over everybody in Germany but in fascism, the people get to freely vote for their dictator, so he convinced everyone to vote for him because he was promising the world for them. Once, Hitler became leader, he started to take over many parts of Europe. For example, Germany invaded France and this was the event that took France into World War II. Towards the end of the invasion of France Germany only needed one more place to conquer and that was Denmark.
