Lasantha Ariyaratna,2022-09-05 This book examines the challenges posed to Australian copyright law by streaming from the end user perspective It compares the Australian position with the European Union and United States to draw lessons from them regarding how they have dealt with streaming and copyright By critically examining the technological functionality of streaming and the failure of copyright enforcement against the masses it argues for strengthening end user rights The rising popularity of streaming has resulted in a revolutionary change to how digital content such as sound recordings cinematographic films and radio and television broadcasts is used on the internet Superseding the conventional method of downloading using streaming to access digital content has challenged copyright law because it is not clear whether end user acts of streaming constitute copyright infringement These prevailing grey areas between copyright and streaming often make end users feel doubtful about accessing digital content through streaming It is uncertain whether exercising the right of reproduction is appropriately suited for streaming given the ambiguities of embodiment and scope of substantial part Conversely the fair dealing defence in Australia cannot be used aptly to defend end users acts of streaming digital content because end users who use streaming to access digital content can rarely rely on the defence of fair dealing for the purposes of criticism or review news reporting parody or satire or research or study When considering a temporary copy exception end users are at risk of being held liable for infringement when using streaming to access a website that contains infringing digital content even if they lack any knowledge about the content s infringing nature Moreover the grey areas in circumventing geo blocking have made end users hesitant to access websites through streaming because it is not clear whether technological protection measures apply to geo blocking End users have a severe lack of knowledge about whether they can use circumvention methods such as virtual private networks to access streaming websites without being held liable for copyright infringement Despite the intricacies between copyright and access to digital content the recently implemented website blocking laws have emboldened copyright owners while suppressing end users access to digital content This is because the principles of proportionality and public interest have been given less attention when determining website blocking injunctions *Genetically Engineered Crops* National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine,Division on Earth and Life Studies,Board on Agriculture and Natural Resources,Committee on Genetically Engineered Crops: Past Experience and Future Prospects,2017-01-28 Genetically engineered GE crops were first introduced commercially in the 1990s After two decades of production some groups and individuals remain critical of the technology based on their concerns about possible adverse effects on human health the environment and ethical considerations At the same time others are concerned that the technology is not reaching its potential to improve human health and the environment because of

and Stormwater to Enhance Local Water Supplies National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, Division on Earth and Life Studies, Water Science and Technology Board, Committee on the Beneficial Use of Graywater and Stormwater: An Assessment of Risks, Costs, and Benefits, 2016-07-30 Chronic and episodic water shortages are becoming common in many regions of the United States and population growth in water scarce regions further compounds the challenges Increasingly alternative water sources such as graywater untreated wastewater that does not include water from the toilet but generally includes water from bathroom sinks showers bathtubs clothes washers and laundry sinks and stormwater water from rainfall or snow that can be measured downstream in a pipe culvert or stream shortly after the precipitation event are being viewed as resources to supplement scarce water supplies rather than as waste to be discharged as rapidly as possible Graywater and stormwater can serve a range of non potable uses including irrigation toilet flushing washing and cooling although treatment may be needed Stormwater may also be used to recharge groundwater which may ultimately be tapped for potable use In addition to providing additional sources of local water supply harvesting stormwater has many potential benefits including energy savings pollution prevention and reducing the impacts of urban development on urban streams Similarly the reuse of graywater can enhance water supply reliability and extend the capacity of existing wastewater systems in growing cities Despite the benefits of using local alternative water sources to address water demands many questions remain that have limited the broader application of graywater and stormwater capture and use In particular limited information is available on the costs benefits and risks of these projects and beyond the simplest applications many state and local public health agencies have not developed regulatory frameworks for full use of these local water resources To address these issues Using Graywater and Stormwater to Enhance Local Water Supplies analyzes the risks costs and benefits on various uses of graywater and stormwater This report examines technical economic regulatory and social issues associated with graywater and stormwater capture for a range of uses including non potable urban uses irrigation and groundwater recharge Using Graywater and Stormwater to Enhance Local Water Supplies considers the quality and suitability of water for reuse treatment and storage technologies and human health and environmental risks of water reuse The findings and recommendations of this report will be valuable for water managers citizens of states under a current drought and local and state health and environmental agencies
