theory the oldest of the three was born in the beginning of the 20th century as a branch of low dimensional topology Very soon it became an important area of mathematics with its own powerful techniques In the 1950s combinatorial group theory started to influence rather substantially the theory of Lie algebras thus combinatorial theory of Lie algebras was shaped although the origins of the theory can be traced back to the 1930s In the 1960s B Buchberger introduced what is now known as Gr bner bases This marked the beginning of a new combinatorial era in commu tative algebra It is not very likely that Buchberger was directly influenced by ideas from combinatorial group theory but his famous algorithm bears resemblance to Nielsen s method although in a more sophisticated form
