A Troublesome Inheritance Nicholas Wade, 2014-05-06 Drawing on startling new evidence from the mapping of the genome an explosive new account of the genetic basis of race and its role in the human story Fewer ideas have been more toxic or harmful than the idea of the biological reality of race and with it the idea that humans of different races are biologically different from one another For this understandable reason the idea has been banished from polite academic conversation Arguing that race is more than just a social construct can get a scholar run out of town or at least off campus on a rail Human evolution the consensus view insists ended in prehistory Inconveniently as Nicholas Wade argues in *A Troublesome Inheritance* the consensus view cannot be right And in fact we know that populations have changed in the past few thousand years to be lactose tolerant for example and to survive at high altitudes Race is not a bright line distinction by definition it means that the more human populations are kept apart the more they evolve their own distinct traits under the selective pressure known as Darwinian evolution For many thousands of years most human populations stayed where they were and grew distinct not just in outward appearance but in deeper senses as well Wade the longtime journalist covering genetic advances for *The New York Times* draws widely on the work of scientists who have made crucial breakthroughs in establishing the reality of recent human evolution The most provocative claims in this book involve the genetic basis of human social habits What we might call middle class social traits thrift docility nonviolence have been slowly but surely inculcated genetically within agrarian societies Wade argues These values obviously had a strong cultural component but Wade points to evidence that agrarian societies evolved away from hunter gatherer societies in some crucial respects Also controversial are his findings regarding the genetic basis of traits we associate with intelligence such as literacy and numeracy in certain ethnic populations including the Chinese and Ashkenazi Jews Wade believes deeply in the fundamental equality of all human peoples He also believes that science is best served by pursuing the truth without fear and if his mission to arrive at a coherent summa of what the new genetic science does and does not tell us about race and human history leads straight into a minefield then so be it This will not be the last word on the subject but it will begin a powerful and overdue conversation

An Analysis of Richard J. Herrnstein and Charles Murray's *The Bell Curve* Christine Ma, Michael Schapira, 2017-07-05 Herrnstein Murray's *The Bell Curve* is a deeply controversial text that raises serious issues about the stakes involved in reasoning and interpretation The authors central contention is that intelligence is the primary factor determining social outcomes for individuals and that it is a better predictor of achievement than income background or socioeconomic status One of the major issues raised by the book was its discussion of racial differences in intelligence and its contention that there is a link between the low observed test scores and social outcomes for African Americans and their lack of social attainment While the authors produce and interpret a great deal of data to back up their contentions they ultimately fail to tackle the problem that neither intelligence nor race have widely accepted definitions in biology anthropology or

sociology In consequence the book it has been termed both racist and pseudoscientific thanks to what its critics see as both its faulty reasoning and its uncautious interpretation of evidence The debate continues to this day with academics on both sides engaged in fierce arguments over what can be argued from the data that Herrnstein and Murray used The Diagrammatics of 'Race' Marianne Sommer,2024-07-30 This is the first book that engages with the history of diagrams in physical evolutionary and genetic anthropology Since their establishment as scientific tools for classification in the eighteenth century diagrams have been used to determine but also to deny kinship between human groups In nineteenth century craniometry they were omnipresent in attempts to standardize measurements on skulls for hierarchical categorization In particular the human family tree was central for evolutionary understandings of human diversity being used on both sides of debates about whether humans constitute different species well into the twentieth century With recent advances in ancient DNA analyses the tree diagram has become more contested than ever does human relatedness take the shape of a network Are human individual genomes mosaics made up of different ancestries Sommer examines the epistemic and political role of these visual representations in the history of race as an anthropological category How do such diagrams relate to imperial and post colonial practices and ideologies but also to liberal and humanist concerns The Diagrammatics of Race concentrates on Western projects from the late 1700s into the present to diagrammatically define humanity subdividing and ordering it including the concomitant endeavors to acquire representative samples bones blood or DNA from all over the world Contributing to the diagrammatic turn in the humanities and social sciences it reveals connections between diagrams in anthropology and other visual traditions including in religion linguistics biology genealogy breeding and eugenics

what we value about the genos on which nations are said to be founded This is an urgent question for democracies We value the mode of being in time that anchors us in the past and in the future that is among those who have been and those who might yet be If the genos is a group constituted by this generational time the demos was invented as the anti genos with no criterion of inheritance and instead only occurring according to the interruption of revolutionary time Insofar as the demos persists we experience it as a sort of genos for example the democratic nation state As a result democracies are caught in a bind disavowing genos thinking while cherishing the temporal forms of genos life they abhor genocidal violence but perpetuate and disguise it This is the genocide paradox O Byrne traces the problem through our commitment to existential categories from Aristotle to the life taxonomies of Linnaeus and Darwin through anthropologies of kinship that tether us to the social world the shortfalls of ethical theory into the history of democratic theory and the defensive tactics used by real existing democracies when it came to defining genocide for the U N Genocide Convention She argues that although models of democracy all make room for contestation they fail to grasp its generational structure or acknowledge the generational content of our lives They cultivate ignorance of the contingency and precarity of the relations that create and sustain us The danger of doing so is immense It leaves us unprepared for confronting democracy's deficits and its struggle to entertain multiple temporalities In addition it leaves us unprepared for understanding the relation between demos and violence and the ability of good enough citizens to tolerate the slow burning destruction of marginalized peoples What will it take to envision an anti genocidal democracy
