special anti aircraft artillery battalions were created by the US Army Several of these battalions including the 452nd Antiaircraft Artillery AAA Battalion were staffed by Black American soldiers The 452nd AAA deployed in England in November 1943 and went ashore in Normandy France in June 1944 Assigned to XII Corps part of General Patton s Third Army the 452nd AAA was a valuable asset of the US Army Armed with the deadly 40mm Bofors gun and the 50 cal M45 Quadmount these Black soldiers protected bridges field artillery battalions and other vital installations during the Second World War Some of the white soldiers from the field artillery battalions the 452nd AAA was protecting doubted their abilities but quickly came to appreciate the accuracy and coolness under fire of the Black soldiers Credited with shooting down almost 68 hostile aircraft one of the highest among AAA units in Europe the 452nd AAA has rightfully earned its place in the history of the US Armed Forces during the Second World War Although the battalion s motto was We Guard the Skyways it would perhaps be more appropriate to call them Airplane Destroyers Almost 80 years after the war this outstanding unit s history is finally made public

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
