Life in Roman Empire Stanford Mc Krause,1951 At its peak the population of the city of Rome probably exceeded one million However the Roman Empire was an agricultural society where most people made a living from farming although there were many artisans Only a small minority of the population lived in cities There were basically two types of people citizens and non citizens Roman citizens had certain privileges In 212 AD all free people in the Roman Empire became citizens Edict of Caracalla
