

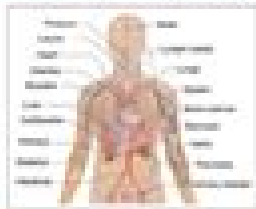

Structural levels

Also known as the levels of organization of the human body

- 1. Chemical level - study of the chemical composition of the body
- 2. Cellular level - study of the structure and function of cells
- 3. Tissue level - study of the structure and function of tissues
- 4. Organ level - study of the structure and function of organs
- 5. System level - study of the structure and function of body systems
- 6. Organism level - study of the structure and function of the whole body

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the body



Characteristics of living organisms

- 1. Organization - the body is organized into a hierarchy of levels
- 2. Growth - the body grows and develops
- 3. Reproduction - the body reproduces
- 4. Response - the body responds to its environment

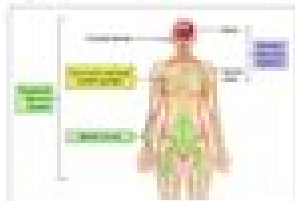
Body systems

- 1. Definition - a body system is a group of organs that work together to perform a specific function
- 2. Examples - digestive system, respiratory system, circulatory system, etc.
- 3. Function - body systems perform specific functions for the body

RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

Functions

- 1. Ventilation - the process of moving air in and out of the lungs
- 2. Gas exchange - the process of exchanging oxygen and carbon dioxide between the lungs and the blood
- 3. Regulation of pH - the process of maintaining the pH of the blood



Structure

- 1. Trachea - the windpipe, which carries air from the lungs to the rest of the body
- 2. Bronchi - the airways that branch off from the trachea
- 3. Lungs - the organs where gas exchange takes place

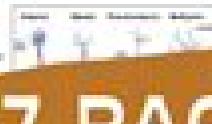
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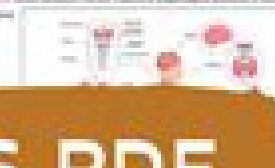


Body systems

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ORGAN SYSTEMS OF THE BODY

- 1. Definition - an organ system is a group of organs that work together to perform a specific function
- 2. Examples - digestive system, respiratory system, circulatory system, etc.
- 3. Function - organ systems perform specific functions for the body



ENDOCRINE SYSTEM

- 1. Definition - the endocrine system is a group of glands that secrete hormones into the bloodstream
- 2. Examples - pituitary gland, thyroid gland, adrenal gland, etc.
- 3. Function - the endocrine system regulates the body's metabolism, growth, and development



Functions of the endocrine system

- 1. Regulation of metabolism
- 2. Regulation of growth and development
- 3. Regulation of the immune system
- 4. Regulation of the reproductive system
- 5. Regulation of the circulatory system
- 6. Regulation of the nervous system

Characteristics of the endocrine system

- 1. Hormones are secreted by the endocrine glands
- 2. Hormones travel through the bloodstream
- 3. Hormones act on target organs
