Anatomy

The study of the structure of the human body and its internal organs.

Physiology

The study of the function of the human body and its internal organs.

Structural levels

Studying the human body at the cellular, tissue, organ, and system levels.

- 1. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.
- 2. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.
- 3. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.
- 4. **System level** - study of the structure and function of systems.
- 5. **Whole body level** - study of the structure and function of the whole body.

CELLS AND TISSUES

Cells are the basic units of structure and function of the human body.



Organization of cellular levels

Cells are organized into tissues, organs, and systems.

1. **Cellular level** - study of the structure and function of cells.

2. **Tissue level** - study of the structure and function of tissues.

3. **Organ level** - study of the structure and function of organs.

4. **System level** - study of the structure and function of systems.

5. **Whole body level** - study of the structure and function of the whole body.



The **Epithelium** is the outermost layer of cells that covers the body.

1. **Epithelial cells** - cells that cover the body.

2. **Connective tissue** - tissue that connects the body.

3. **Muscle tissue** - tissue that contracts the body.

4. **Nervous tissue** - tissue that transmits signals.

5. **Whole body level** - study of the structure and function of the whole body.

ORGANS

Organs are structures made up of different types of tissues.

1. **Heart** - pumps blood throughout the body.

2. **Lungs** - exchange gases between the body and the environment.

3. **Stomach** - digests food and absorbs nutrients.

4. **Intestines** - absorb nutrients and eliminate waste.

5. **Bladder** - stores urine.

6. **Uterus** - carries and nurtures the developing fetus.

7. **Vagina** - canal for childbirth and menstruation.

8. **Penis** - organ for sexual intercourse and urination.

9. **Testes** - produce sperm and testosterone.

10. **Ovaries** - produce eggs and estrogen.

11. **Thyroid** - produces thyroid hormone.

12. **Parathyroid** - produces parathyroid hormone.

13. **Pituitary** - produces growth hormone.

14. **Hypothalamus** - controls body temperature.

15. **Adipose** - stores fat.

16. **Spleen** - filters blood and stores red blood cells.

17. **Liver** - filters toxins and produces bile.

18. **Gallbladder** - stores bile.

19. **Pancreas** - produces insulin and digestive enzymes.

20. **Salivary glands** - produce saliva.

21. **Esophagus** - transports food from the mouth to the stomach.

22. **Stomach** - digests food.

23. **Small intestine** - absorbs nutrients.

24. **Large intestine** - eliminates waste.

25. **Rectum** - stores feces.

26. **Anus** - eliminates waste from the body.

27. **Urethra** - carries urine from the bladder to the outside of the body.
