SUMMARY:

THE NERVOUS SYSTEM IS A COMPLEX NETWORK OF NEURONS THAT FACILITATE COMMUNICATION AND COORDINATION WITHIN THE BODY. ESSENTIALLY, DIVIDING DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE BODY INTO SENSORY AND MOTORIAL PARTS. IT PLAYS A FUNDAMENTAL ROLE IN CONTROLLING BODY FUNCTIONS, RESPONDING TO STIMULI, AND MAINTAINING HOMEOSTASIS.

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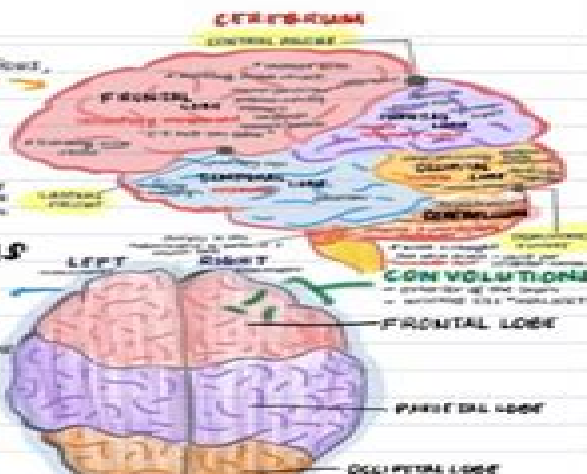

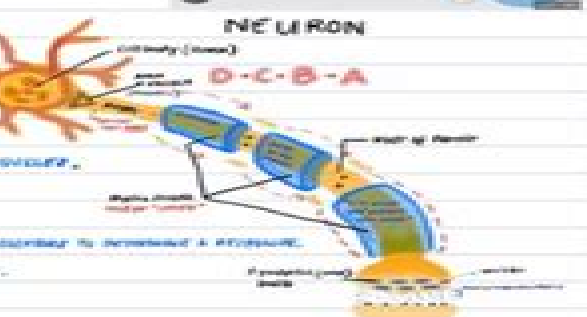
