Introduction to Anatomy and Physiology

Definition: The study of the structure and function of the human body.

Branches:

- Anatomy:** The study of the structure of the body.
- Physiology:** The study of the function of the body.

Levels of Organization:

1. Chemical level
2. Cellular level
3. Tissue level
4. Organ level
5. Organ system level
6. Organism level

Homeostasis

Definition: The process by which the body maintains a stable internal environment.

Components:

- Sensors:** Detect changes in the environment.
- Integrating Centers:** Process information and initiate a response.
- Effectors:** Carry out the response.

Types of Homeostasis:

- Positive Feedback:** Amplifies a response.
- Negative Feedback:** Opposes a response.

Cell Structure

Cell: The basic unit of life.

Parts of a Cell:

- Cell Membrane:** Controls what enters and leaves the cell.
- Nucleus:** Contains genetic material.
- Mitochondria:** Produces energy.
- Ribosomes:** Synthesize proteins.

Integumentary System

Parts: Skin, hair, nails.

Functions: Protection, regulation of body temperature, sensation.

Skin Layers:

1. Epidermis
2. Dermis
3. Hypodermis

Muscular System

Parts: Skeletal muscles, smooth muscles, cardiac muscles.

Functions: Movement, posture, heat production.

Types of Muscles:

- Skeletal:** Voluntary, striated.
- Smooth:** Involuntary, non-striated.
- Cardiac:** Involuntary, striated.

Nervous System

Parts: Brain, spinal cord, nerves.

Functions: Control, coordination, communication.

Types of Neurons:

- Sensory:** Carry information from receptors to the brain.
- Motor:** Carry information from the brain to effectors.
- Interneurons:** Connect sensory and motor neurons.

Endocrine System

Parts: Pituitary, thyroid, adrenal, etc.

Functions: Regulation of metabolism, growth, development.

Hormones: Chemical messengers.

Immune System

Parts: White blood cells, antibodies.

Functions: Defense against pathogens.

Types of Immune Response:

- Innate:** Immediate, non-specific.
- Adaptive:** Slower, specific.

Respiratory System

Parts: Lungs, trachea, bronchi.

Functions: Exchange of gases.

Processes: Ventilation, diffusion.

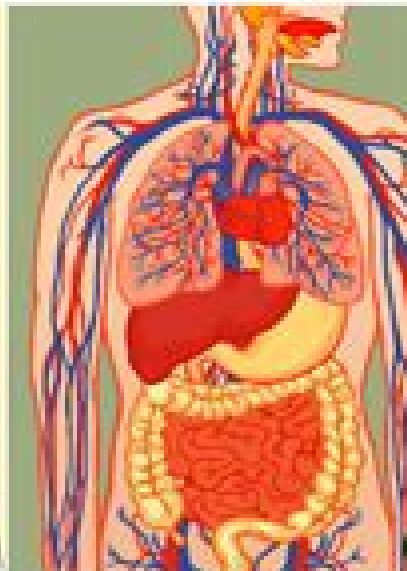
Circulatory System

Parts: Heart, blood vessels.

Functions: Transport of blood.

Types of Circulation:

- Systemic:** Carries blood to and from the rest of the body.
- Pulmonary:** Carries blood to and from the lungs.



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Parts: Skin, hair, nails.

Functions: Protection, regulation of body temperature, sensation.

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Muscular System: The body's engine.

Parts: Skeletal muscles, smooth muscles, cardiac muscles.

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Digestive System

Parts: Mouth, esophagus, stomach, intestines.

Functions: Breakdown of food, absorption of nutrients.

Processes: Ingestion, digestion, absorption.

Excretory System

Parts: Kidneys, ureters, bladder.

Functions: Removal of waste products.

Processes: Filtration, reabsorption, secretion.

Reproductive System

Parts: Ovaries, uterus, vagina, penis, testes.

Functions: Production of gametes, fertilization.

Processes: Oogenesis, spermatogenesis.
