The purpose of this meta-analysis was to compile every instance of early lightsaber use and discover its origins. Fisto and Kenobi used many galactic databases and archives to find evidence of the clean, blackened slash-marks that are characteristic of lightsabers. They found that the precursors to lightsabers – the forcesabers – were first developed by the Rakata around 36,453 BBY. However, it was not until 15,500 BBY that a member of the Je'daii Order known as the “Weapons Master” created the “First Blade” and instituted lightsabers as the official weapon of the Order. The main limitation that the researchers noted was that they did not understand why the Je'daii needed a power pack attached to the earliest lightsabers: it is strange that these lightsabers needed so much external energy to work because the Je'daii had access to the same materials that build modern lightsabers. A limitation the researchers missed was the fact that they did not actually
