The proper integration of brain oscillations provides for the phenomenon of binding and central coherence Brain augmentation may foster the normalization of brain oscillations in nervous system disorders These techniques hold the promise of being applied remotely under the supervision of medical personnel thus overcoming the obstacle of travel in order to obtain healthcare At present traditional thinking would argue the possibility of synergism among different modalities of brain augmentation as a way of increasing their overall effectiveness and improving therapeutic selectivity Thinking outside of the box would also provide for the implementation of
