



The Digestive System

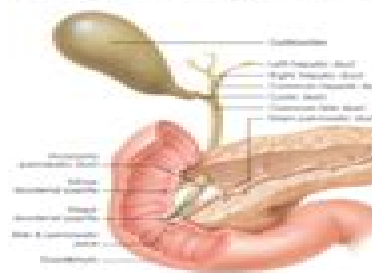
What is the digestive system?

The digestive system, or **gastrointestinal tract**, is a tract of organs that is responsible for digesting and absorbing nutrients from food. Food enters through the mouth, is broken down in the stomach, and then moves through the small intestine, where nutrients are absorbed. The digestive system also includes accessory organs that help in the process, such as the liver, pancreas, and gallbladder.

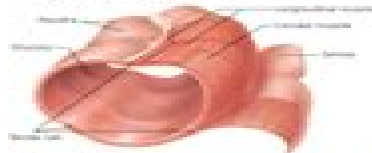


Liver, pancreas & gallbladder

After leaving the stomach, digested material enters the duodenum, the first part of the small intestine, where it is mixed with bile secreted by the **liver**. The liver is a large organ on the right side of the abdomen. It produces bile, which is stored in the **gallbladder**. The pancreas, located behind the stomach, produces pancreatic juice, which is also secreted into the duodenum.

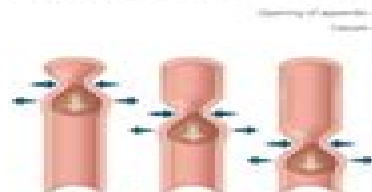


Layers of large intestine



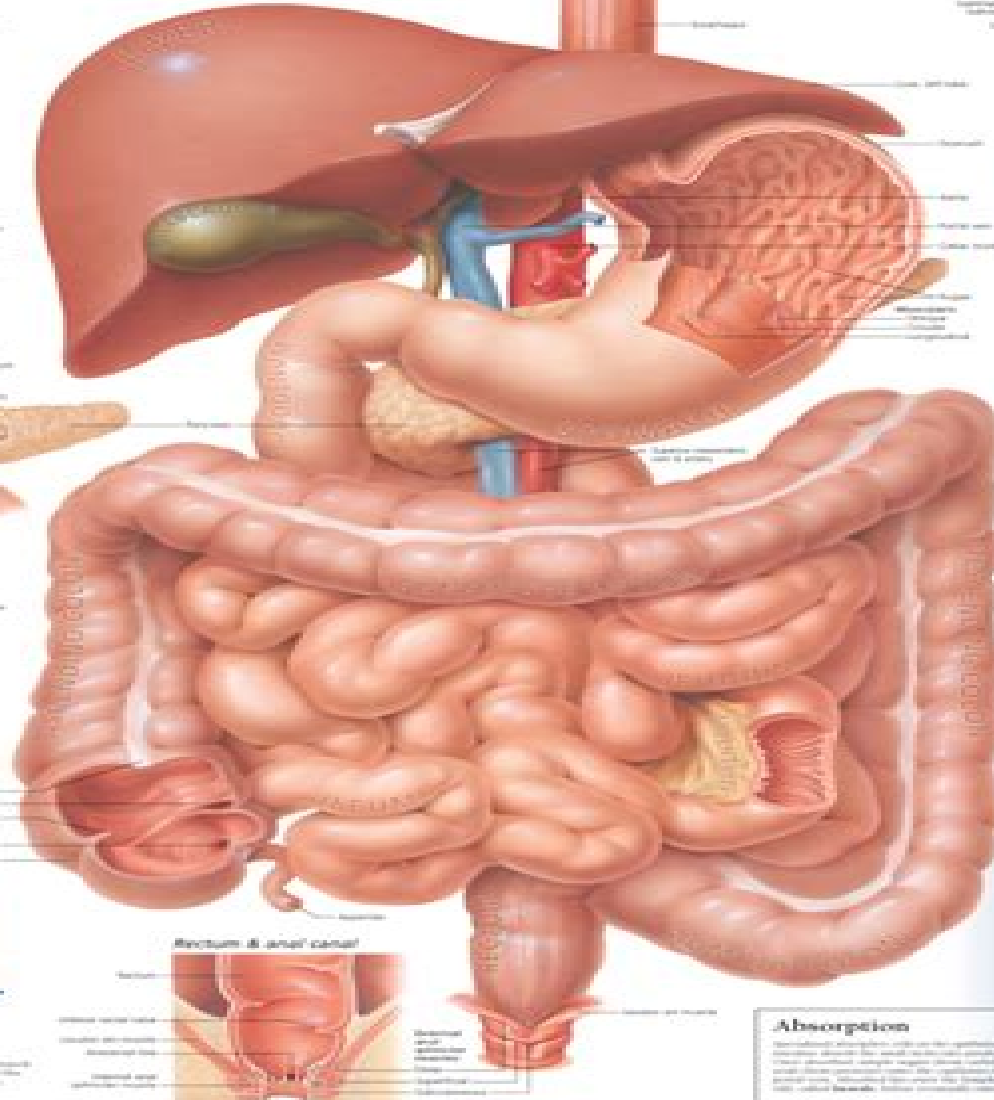
Large intestine

The large intestine consists of the cecum, the caecum, the ascending colon, the transverse colon, the descending colon, the sigmoid colon, and the rectum. It is responsible for absorbing water and electrolytes from the remaining indigestible food matter, and for forming and storing feces.



Peristaltic action

Food material is pushed through the digestive system by a series of powerful muscular contractions called peristalsis. These contractions move the material forward and the wave which, when it moves, the material is pushed forward.



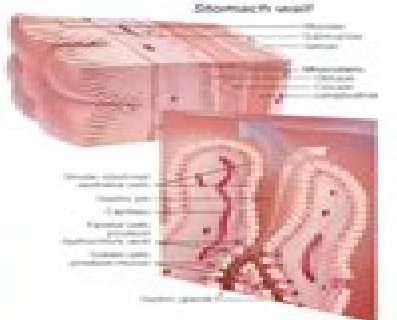
The mouth & salivary glands

Chewing the food breaks it into smaller pieces, making it easier to swallow. Saliva, secreted by the salivary glands, moistens the food and helps in the digestion of carbohydrates. The salivary glands are located in the mouth and produce saliva, which is secreted into the mouth through salivary ducts.



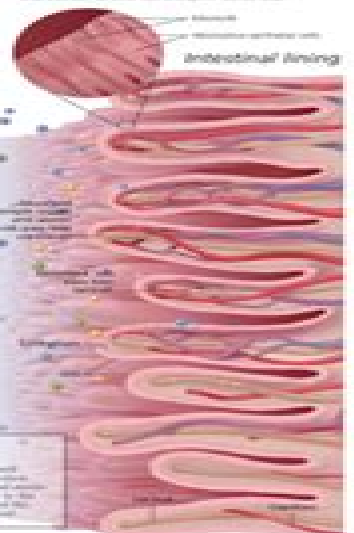
The stomach

The stomach is a large, muscular organ that is responsible for storing and mixing food with gastric juices. It is located in the upper left part of the abdomen. The stomach wall is composed of several layers, including the mucosa, submucosa, muscle, and serosa.



Small intestine

The small intestine is a long, coiled tube that is responsible for the majority of the digestion and absorption of nutrients. It is located in the central part of the abdomen. The small intestine is divided into three parts: the duodenum, the jejunum, and the ileum.



Absorption

The small intestine is responsible for the absorption of most of the nutrients from the food. The villi, which are small finger-like projections on the inner lining of the small intestine, increase the surface area for absorption.
