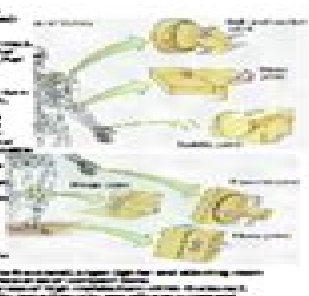


THE SKELETON
The skeleton is the framework of the body, supporting the soft organs and protecting them. It is composed of bones and cartilage. The skull protects the brain, the spine protects the spinal cord, and the rib cage protects the heart and lungs. The bones of the limbs support the body and enable movement.

THE SPINE
The spine is the central part of the skeleton, supporting the head and the rest of the body. It is composed of vertebrae, which are small bones that are joined together by ligaments. The spine is divided into four regions: cervical (neck), thoracic (chest), lumbar (lower back), and sacral (pelvis).

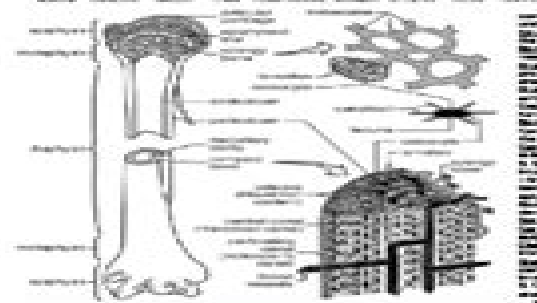
THE RIB CAGE
The rib cage is a bony cage that surrounds the heart and lungs. It is composed of ribs, which are connected to the spine by ligaments. The rib cage protects the internal organs and helps with breathing.



THE HAND AND FOOT
The hand and foot are the distal parts of the upper and lower limbs. They are composed of many small bones that are joined together by ligaments. The bones of the hand and foot are adapted for grasping and walking.

THE PELVIS
The pelvis is the lower part of the trunk, supporting the weight of the body. It is composed of the ilium, ischium, and pubis. The pelvis is joined to the spine by ligaments.

THE FEMUR
The femur is the bone of the thigh. It is the longest bone in the body. It is joined to the pelvis by the hip joint and to the tibia and fibula by the knee joint.

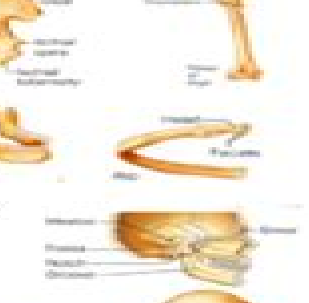


THE TIBIA AND FIBULA
The tibia and fibula are the bones of the lower leg. The tibia is the larger bone, and the fibula is the smaller bone. They are joined together by ligaments. The tibia is joined to the femur by the knee joint and to the tarsals of the foot by the ankle joint.

THE TARSALS
The tarsals are the bones of the ankle. They are small bones that are joined together by ligaments. They support the weight of the body and enable movement.

THE METATARSALS
The metatarsals are the bones of the foot. They are small bones that are joined together by ligaments. They support the weight of the body and enable movement.

THE PHALANGES
The phalanges are the bones of the toes. They are small bones that are joined together by ligaments. They support the weight of the body and enable movement.

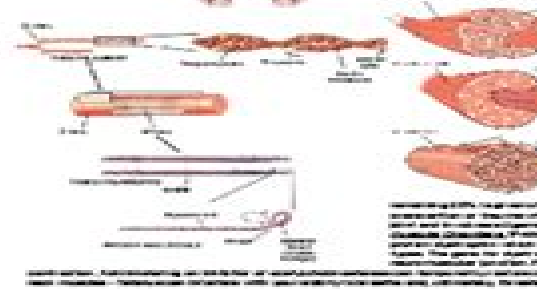


THE MUSCLES
The muscles are the soft tissue that contracts to move the body. They are composed of muscle fibers, which are long, thin cells. The muscles are attached to bones by tendons. The muscles of the torso support the body and enable movement. The muscles of the limbs support the body and enable movement.

THE TENDONS
The tendons are the soft tissue that connects the muscles to the bones. They are composed of collagen fibers, which are strong and flexible. The tendons transmit the force of the muscles to the bones.

THE LIGAMENTS
The ligaments are the soft tissue that connects the bones to each other. They are composed of collagen fibers, which are strong and flexible. The ligaments support the joints and enable movement.

THE CARTILAGE
The cartilage is the soft tissue that cushions the joints. It is composed of a matrix of collagen and proteoglycan. The cartilage reduces friction and absorbs shock.

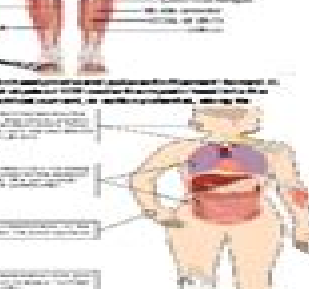
