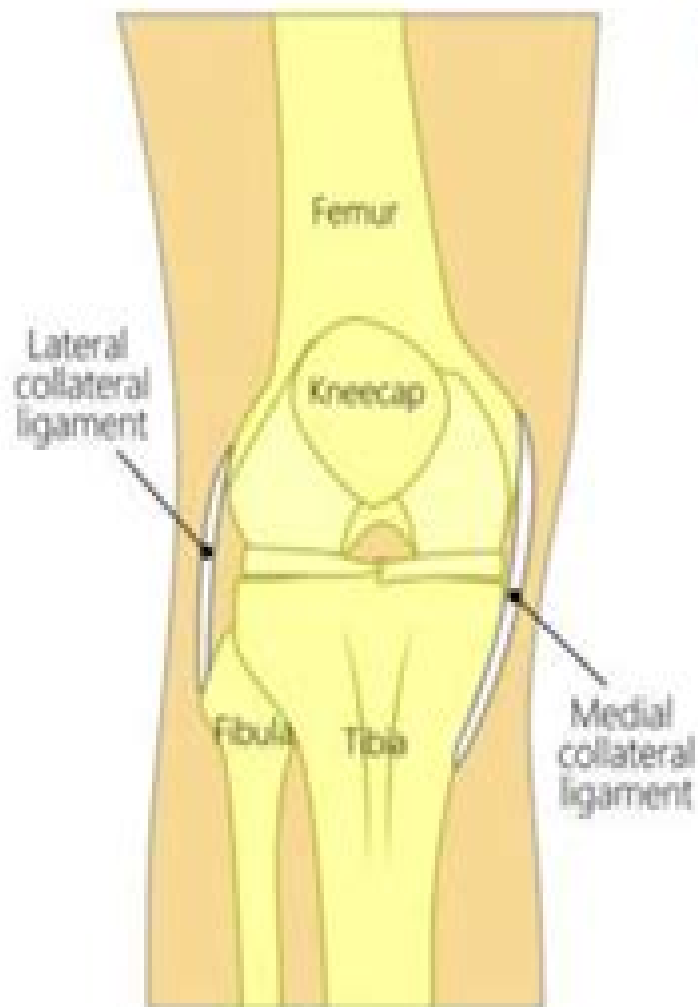
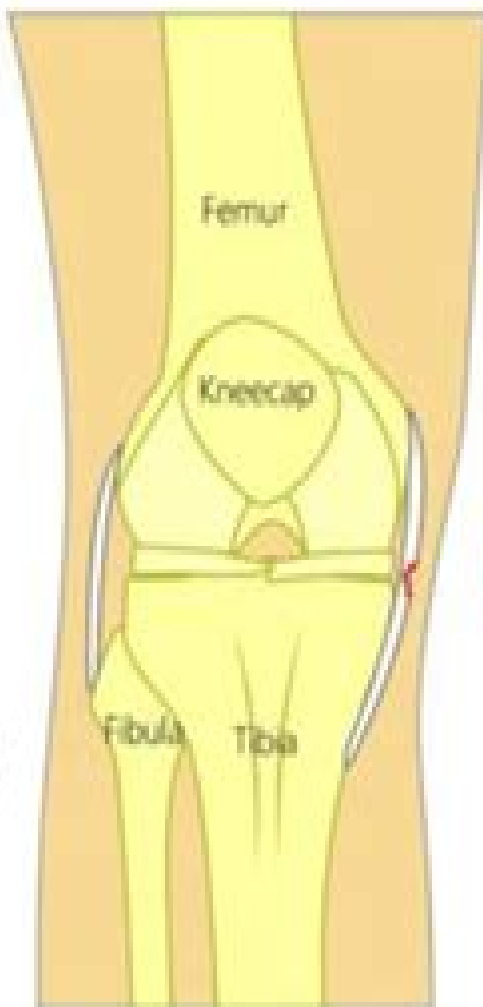


TEAR OF THE MEDIAL COLLATERAL LIGAMENT (MCL) FRONT VIEW OF THE KNEE

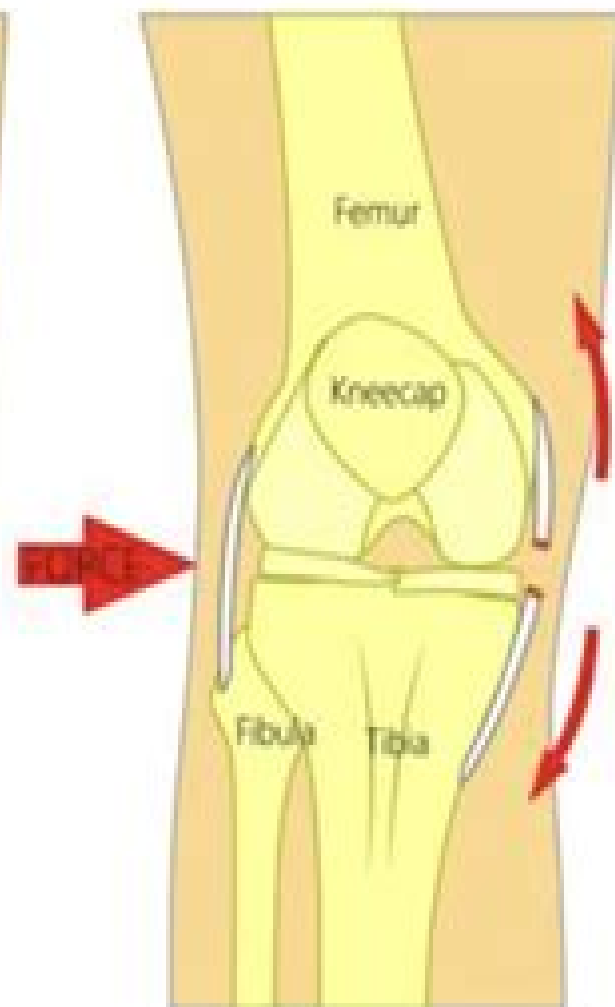
